Waste to profit: repurposing waste products from animal industries

This \$13.9 million project, funded by the Department of Agriculture and Water Resources, Rural Research and Development for Profit programme, is being led by Meat & Livestock Australia and involves APL, Dairy Australia and Australian Meat Processor Corporation

Expected outcomes:

- new technologies that aim to reduce the associated costs of energy and waste treatment
- increased producer profits through the production and use of new fertilisers, animal feeds and other products such as bioplastics
- delivery of advanced technologies to enable wastes from animal production (e.g. feedlots and piggeries), food processing, and water treatment to be converted into valuable products including fertilisers, feeds, chemicals, and energy products for use in agriculture.
