Gap analysis of technical and regulatory requirements for export of Australian pork into China

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Purpose:

- To review China's technical, regulatory and commercial requirements for the production and importation of pork and pork products against Australia's current regulatory and industry practices, standards, inspection, verification and certification systems
- Identify gaps between Chinese and Australian regulatory requirements that may need to be resolved as part of our market access request.

Take home messages:

- The analysis identified limited specific customer or commercial technical gaps between Australian and Chinese requirements
- There are a number of differences between the Australian regulatory market requirements for the production of pork and expected Chinese requirements for the production and importation of pork and pork products
- APL has provided the gap analysis to pork processors. This will help them to develop the systems required to resolve these differences and assist our market access request
