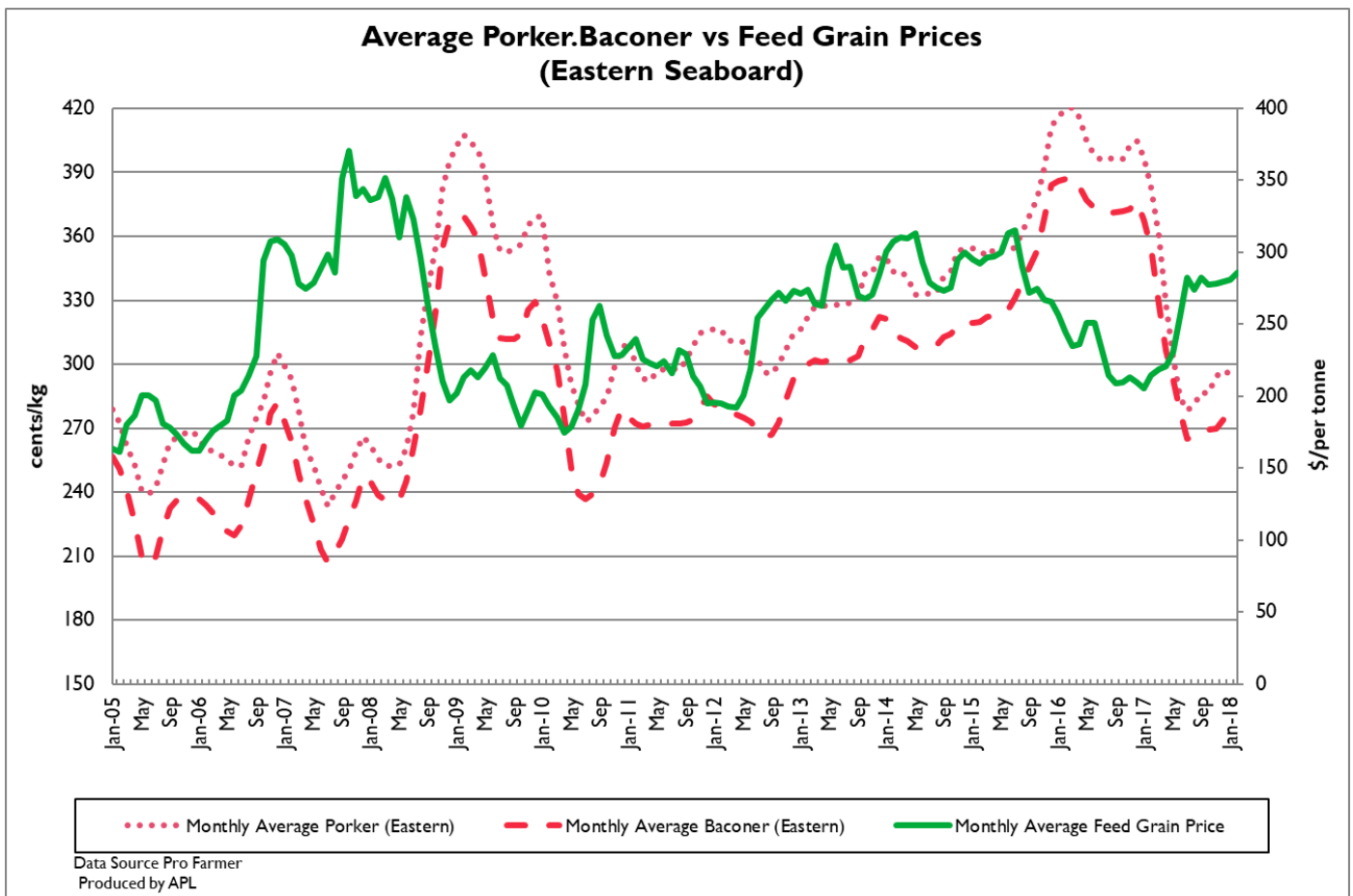

**International and National**

International markets have been relatively flat this week despite some volatility. At the end of last week concerns about dryness in the US was supporting wheat markets and spilling into other grains, however by the start of this week this minor rally had cooled and prices had steadied.

China also announced they were probing the import of sorghum imports from the US, possibly in response to Presidents Trumps announcement of import tariffs on washing machines and solar panels. This brought prices back down early this week.

Nationally, prices have once again tracked sideways this week although there is some buying interest. Domestic markets don't appear to be too bothered by minor volatility in offshore markets, with domestic demand stable enough (but not desperate enough) to carry these through.

**Wheat***Sth QLD/Nth NSW*

Grower selling inquiries appear to be light at present, continuing mainly at hand to mouth level. Rainfall in SQLD and CQLD might limit the numbers on feed.

*Sth NSW/VIC/SA*

Wheat markets continue to be firm, helped by stable offshore markets and a lack of overall selling against some buying interest. Growers appear to be patient in their willingness to sell at present.

**Barley***Sth QLD/Nth NSW*

The drop in the Aussie dollar is expected to boost the export interest in both sorghum and barley. As such it appears most end users are trying to shift from barley to wheat where possible.

*Sth NSW/VIC/SA*

Barley has moved higher this week with a weaker dollar and solid buying interest. Domestic buyers however appear more reluctant as spreads to wheat remain tight, although there is some interest from livestock industries supplementing feed over summer.

**Sorghum**

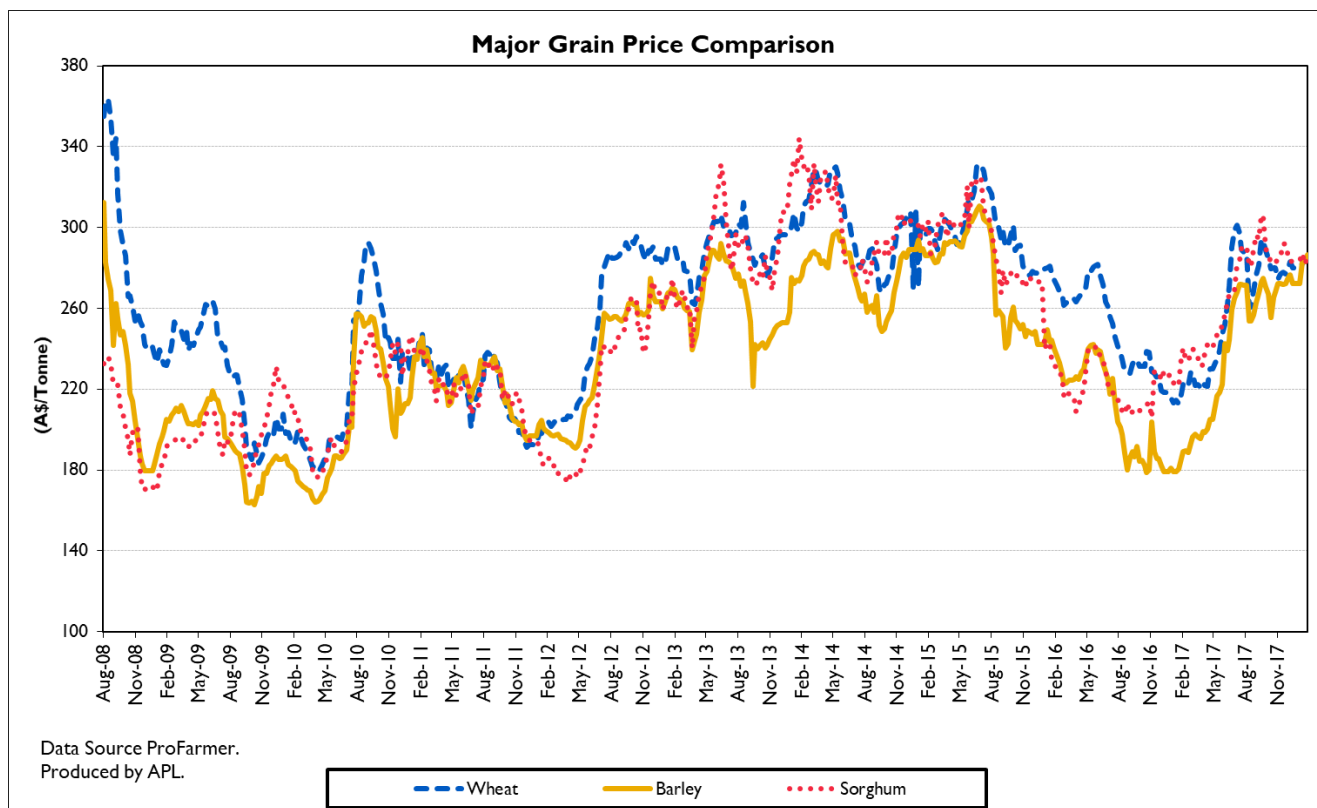
There has been good rainfall across a significant part of cropping areas in SQLD and CQLD. This will arrest yield decline and support later crops in SQLD. There may be some extra demand for exports if the Australian dollar continues to track lower.
