Food Technology Resource for Senior School Students

APL is further developing our 'Pigs in Schools' program to support new capability in students by facilitating their learning about pork, namely how pigs are grown, produced and processed, and how pork is prepared for eating.

This project will develop a new food technology resource for pork, focusing on product development and health. This resource will be linked to both the national senior school curriculum and TAFE food technology and hospitality curriculums and so must be versatile so that it is appropriate for use in both curriculums.

APL's existing educational resources use inquiry-based, 21st century learning methodologies and involve both hands on practical and web-based activities, group work and critical thinking. This will also be required for this resource.
