



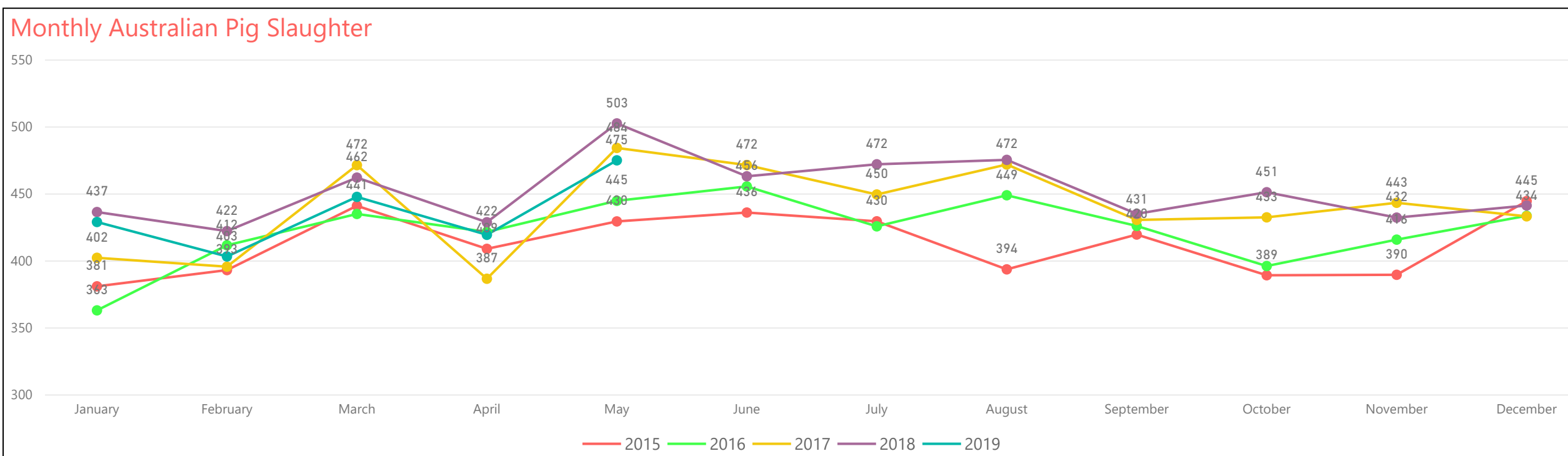

**Graph 1.1 Monthly Australian Pig Domestic Slaughter Trend**





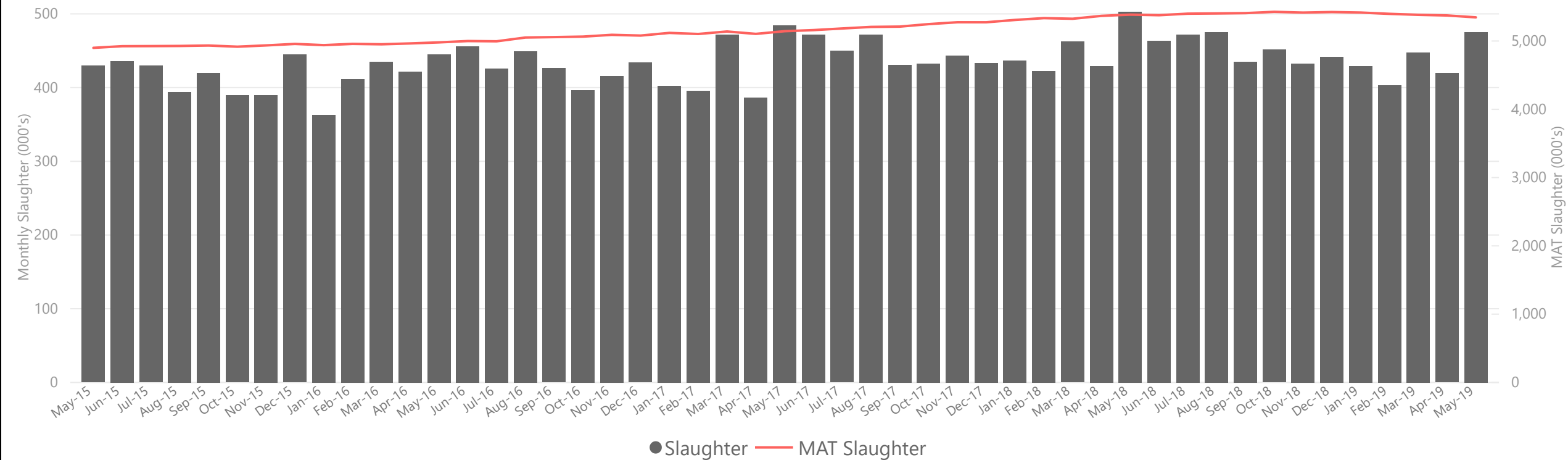

**Graph 2.1: Monthly and MAT Pig Slaughter Numbers**

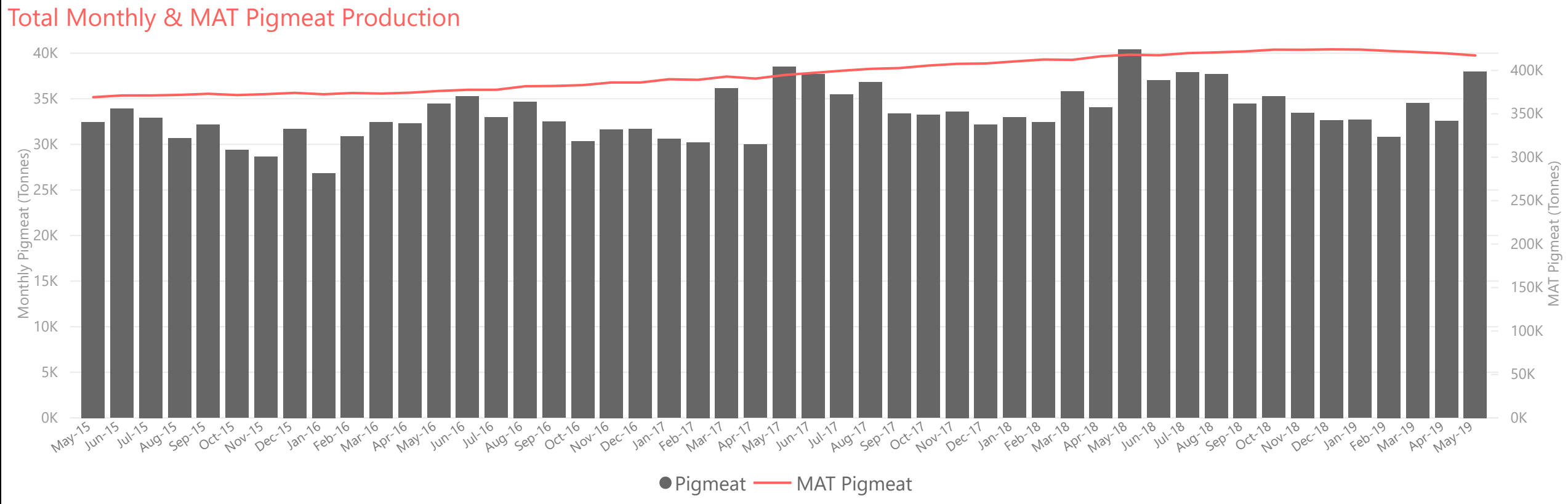

**Graph 2.2: Monthly and MAT Australian Pigmeat Production**





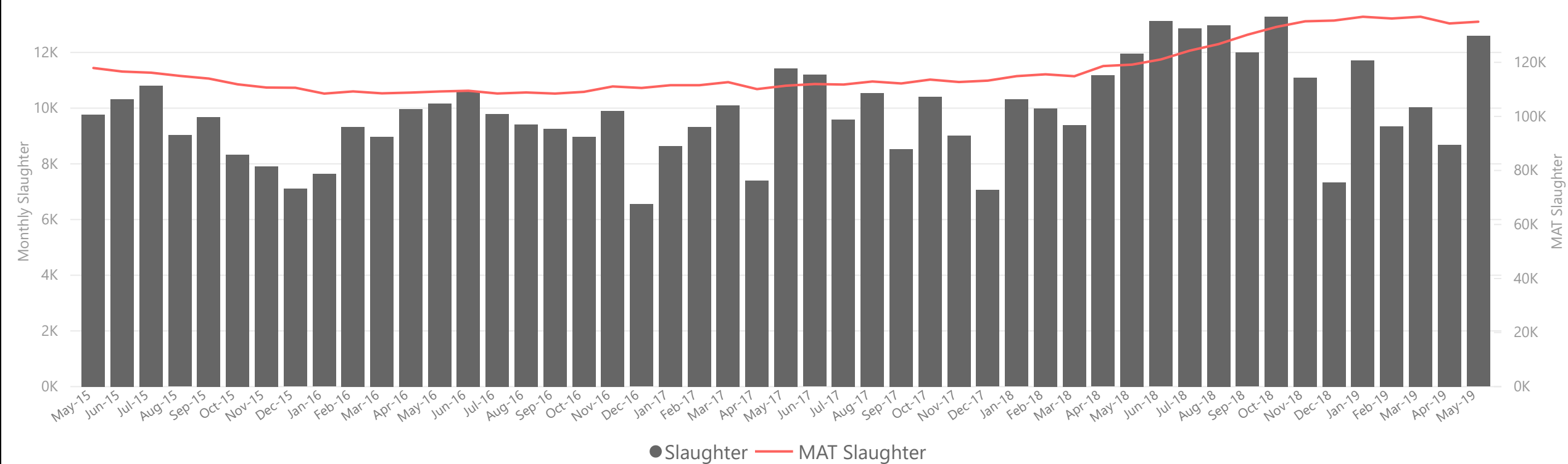

Graph 2.4: Slaughter by State

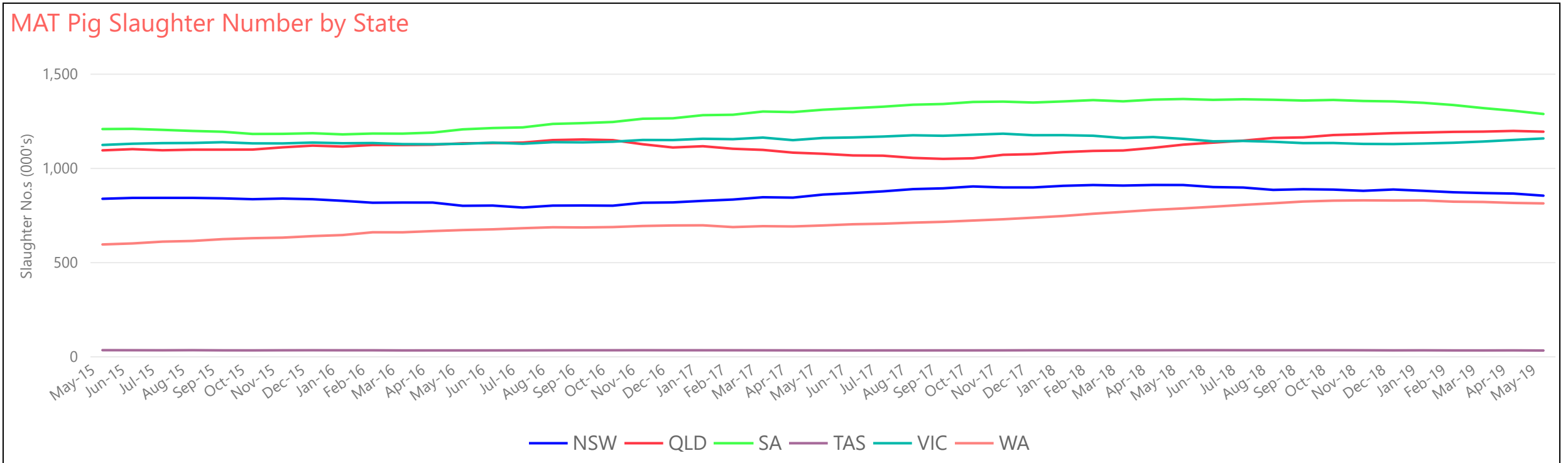

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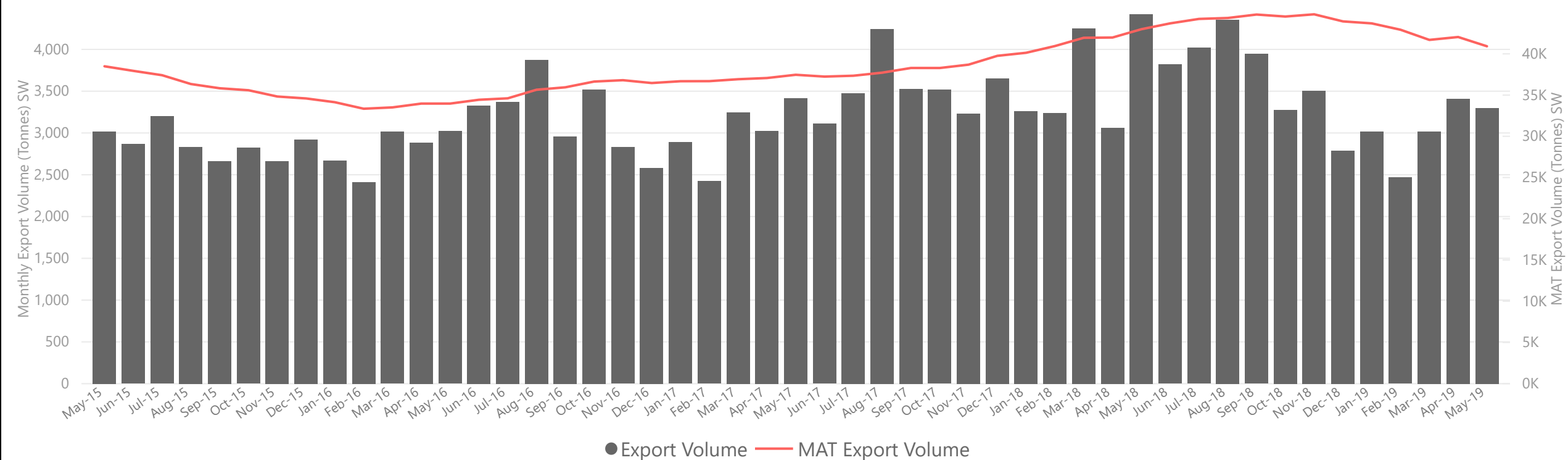

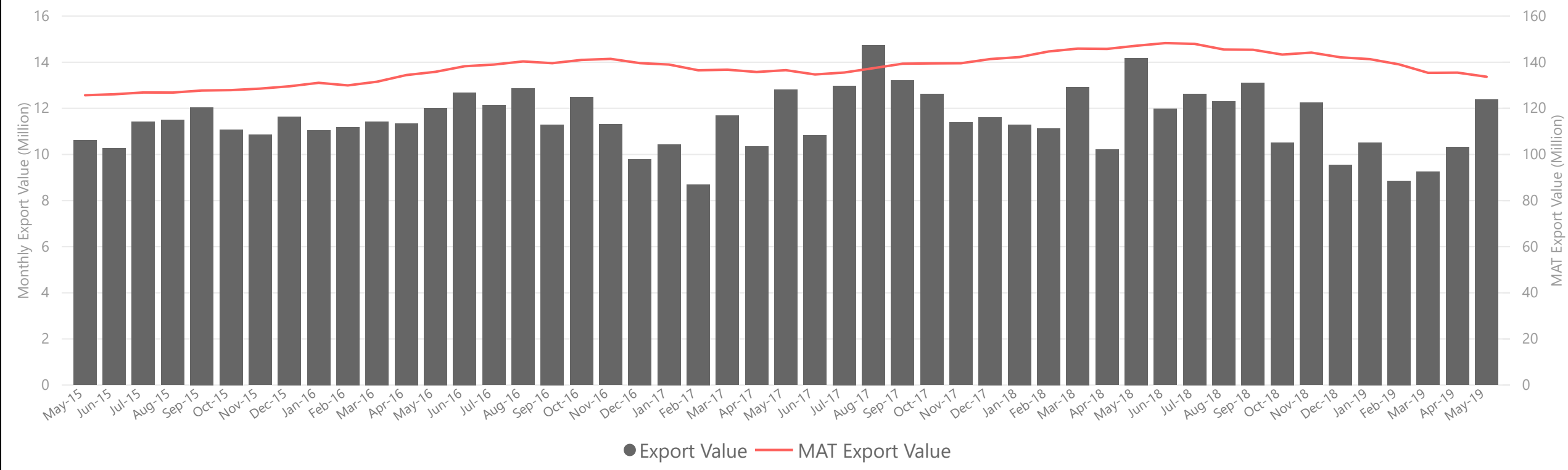

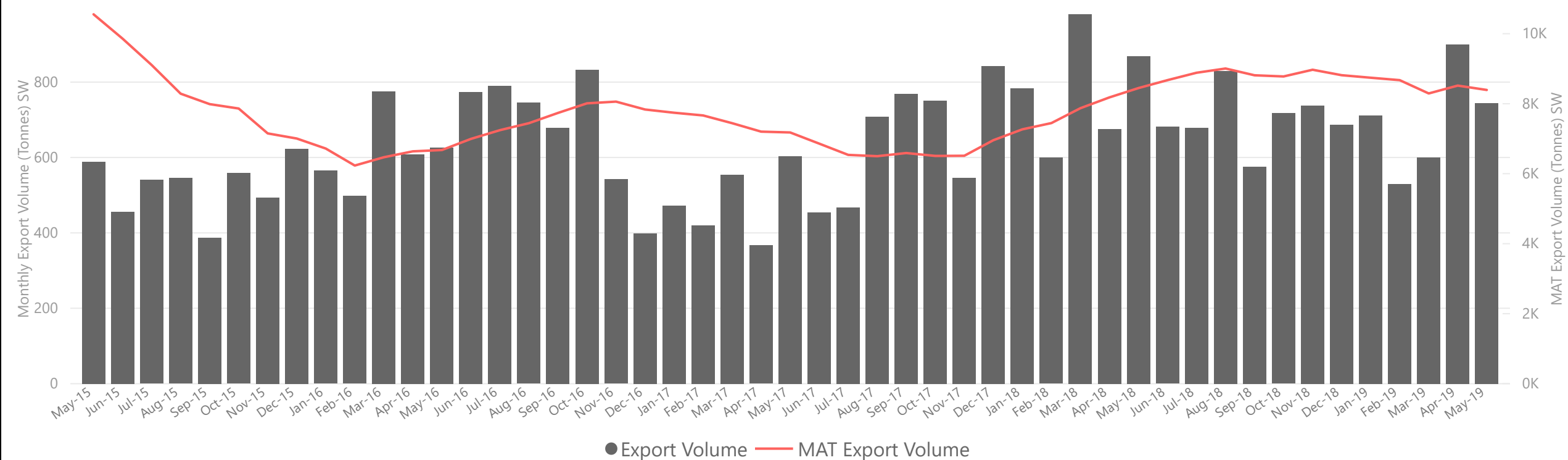

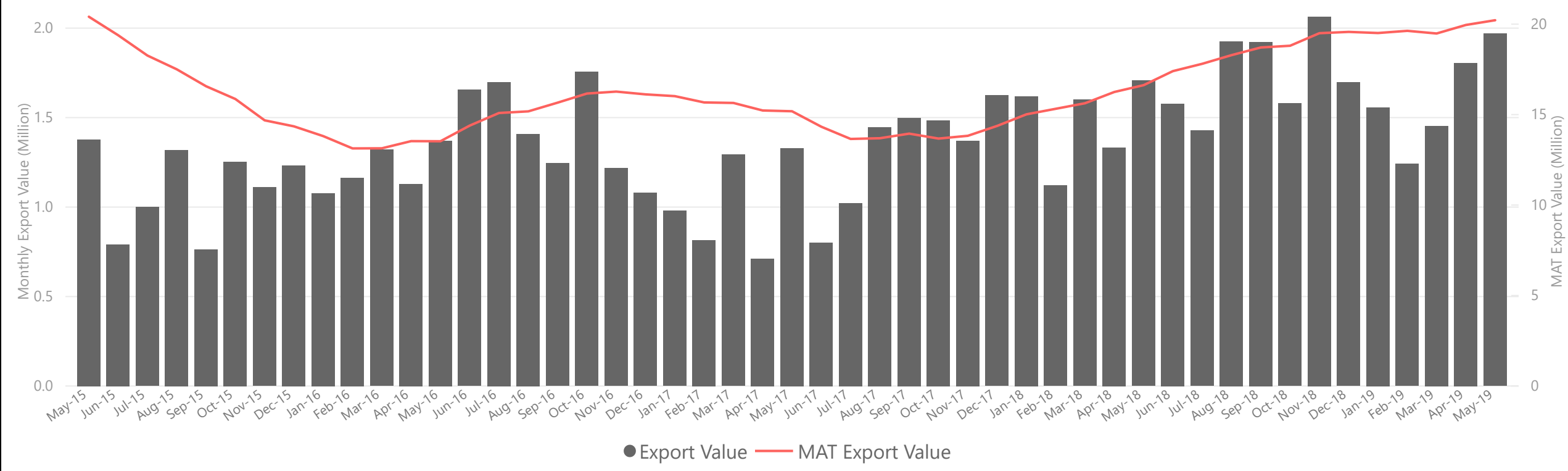

### Value of Australian Farmed Offal Exports



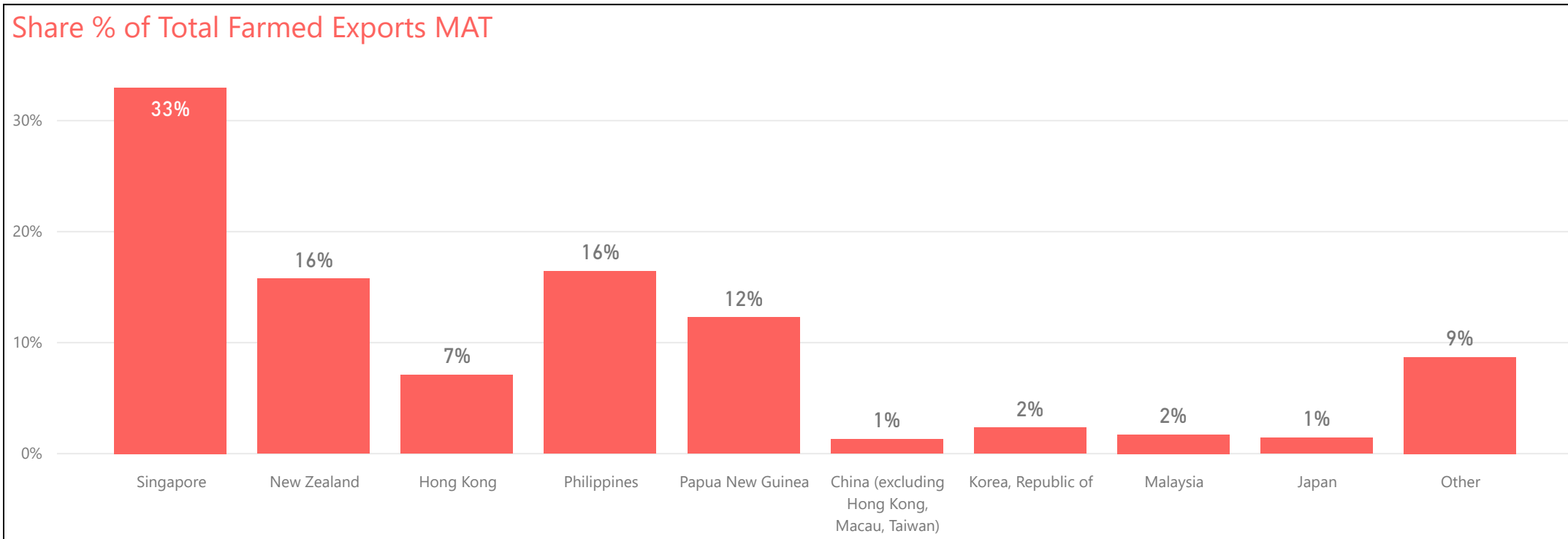

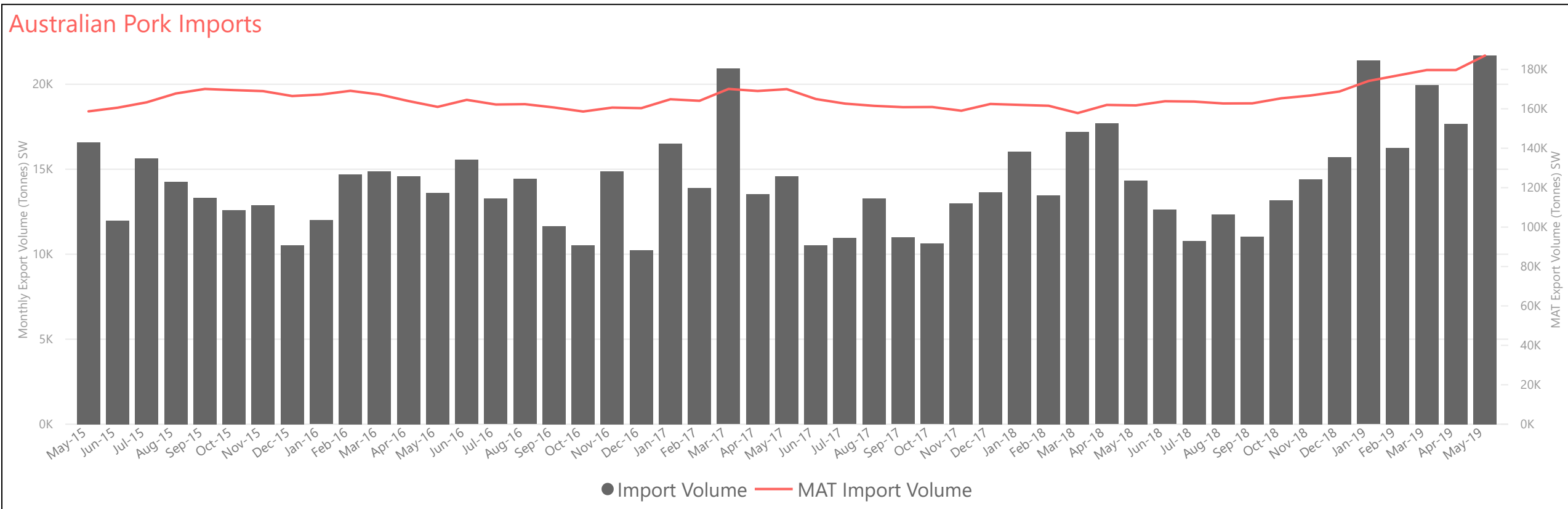

**Graph 4.1: Volume of Australian Pork Imports Monthly and MAT**



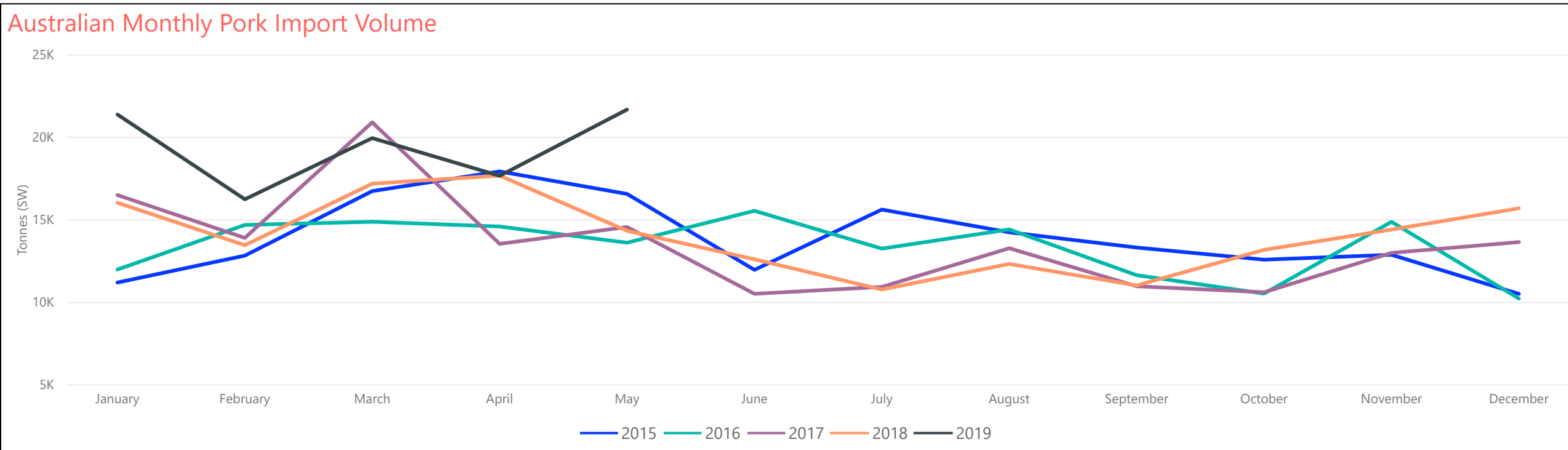

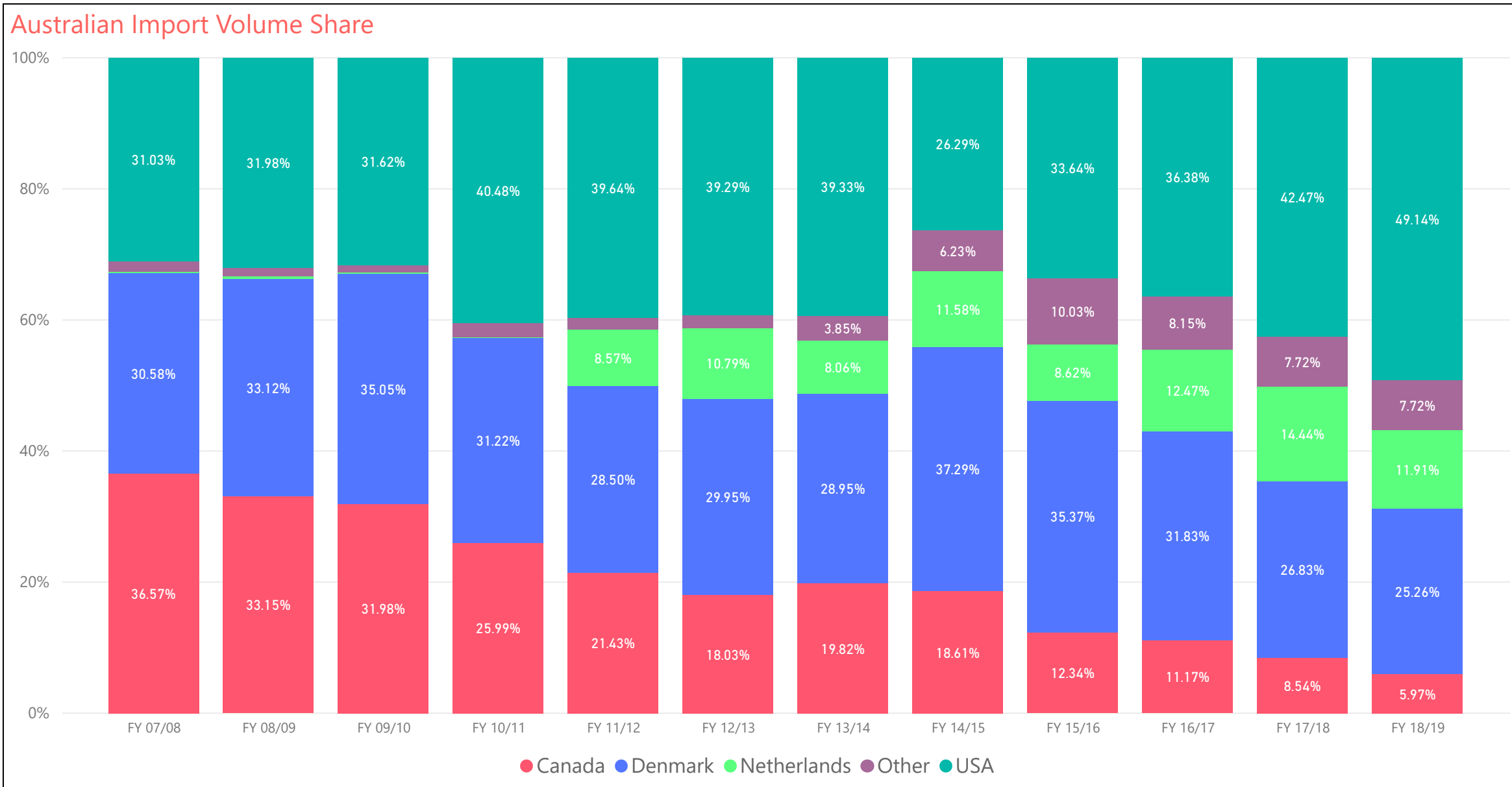
**Graph 4.2: Australian Monthly Pork Import Volume Trends**
