


In order to facilitate the mandatory requirements for saleyards to upload of PigPass NVDs, APL has develop a specific waybill report screen, visible only to NSW saleyards. This document outlines how to complete the upload requirements.



Step 1: Enter Waybill Number into 'Waybill No' field.

Step 2: Enter Source Pic.

- System will verify whether Source PIC is valid or not.
- Valid: No validation message will be shown.
- Not Valid: Validation message will be displayed as shown in below screen, please check and correct "Source Pic No" before proceeding further. If the 'Source Pic No' has been input correctly, please contact the PigPass HelpDesk.




Step 3: Enter the number of pigs into the 'No of Stock' field.




