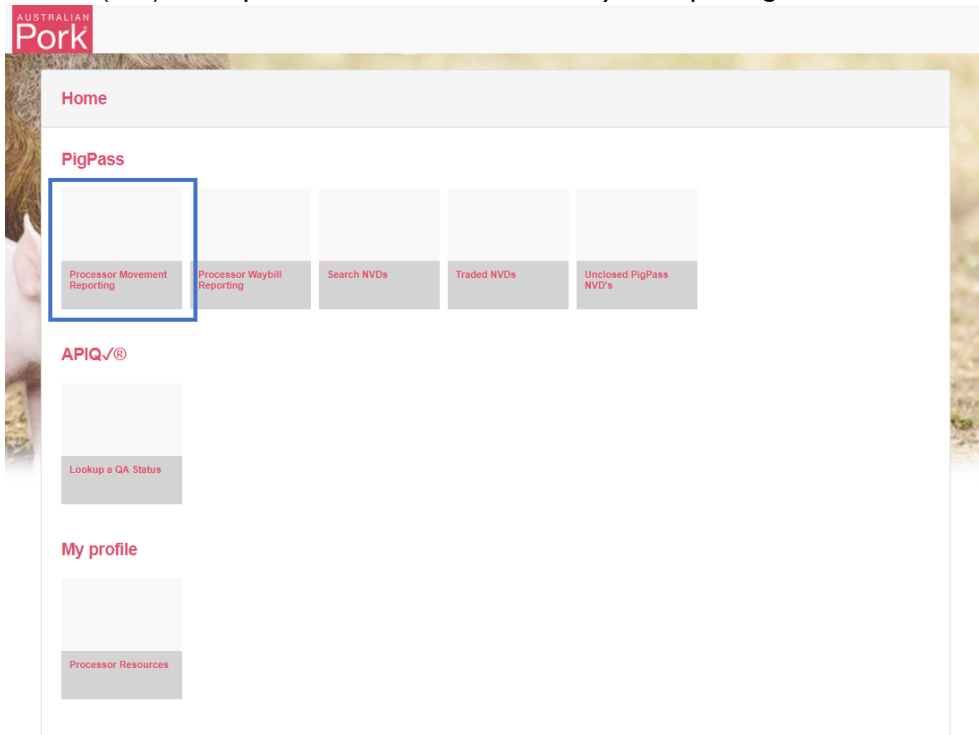




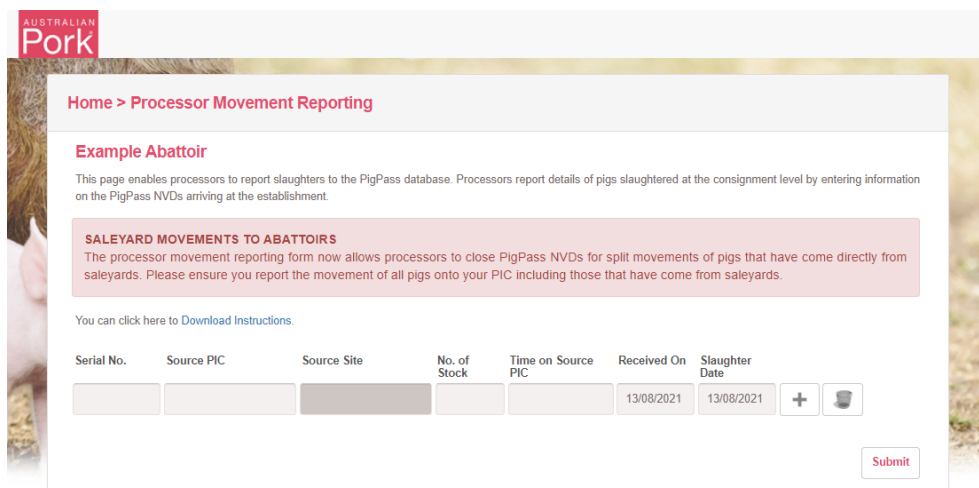
Processor Movement Reporting

This document outlines how to report pig movements reported via a PigPass NVD (PPNVD) onto the abattoir's PIC to the PigPass database. Pig movements reported via a Waybill or Transported Stock Statement (TSS) are reported via the "Processor Waybill Reporting" function.

Step I: Enter PPNVD Serial Number AND Source PIC.

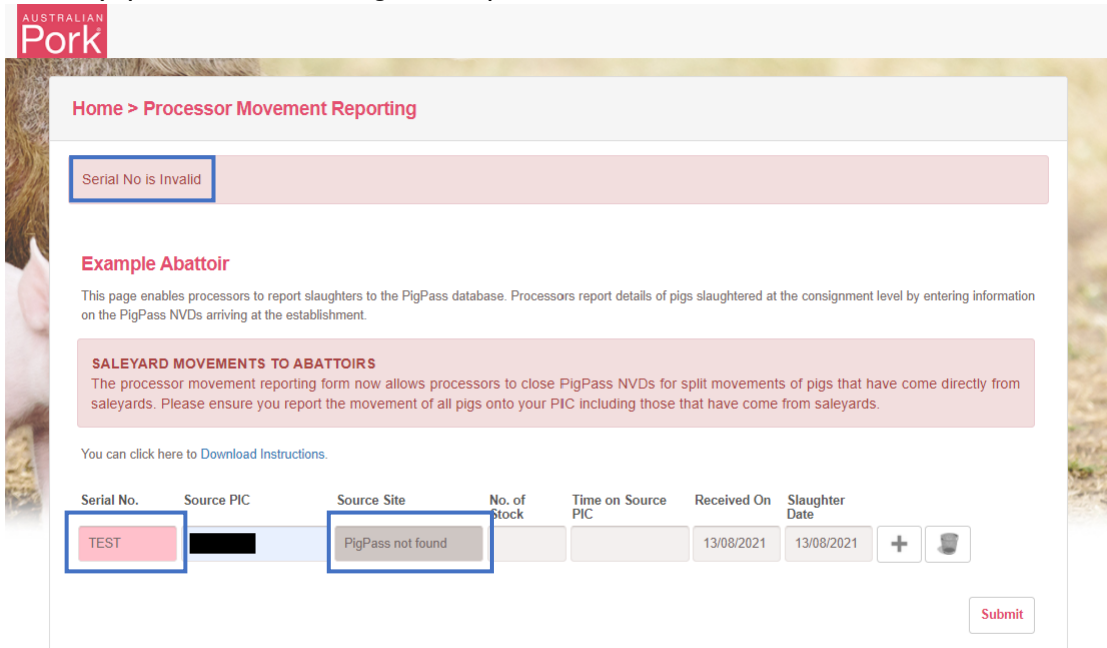
- The system will verify whether the PPNVD 'Serial No' is valid or not.

Step 7: If you would like to enter more than one Serial Number then click + icon, this will create a new row as shown in the screen shot below.



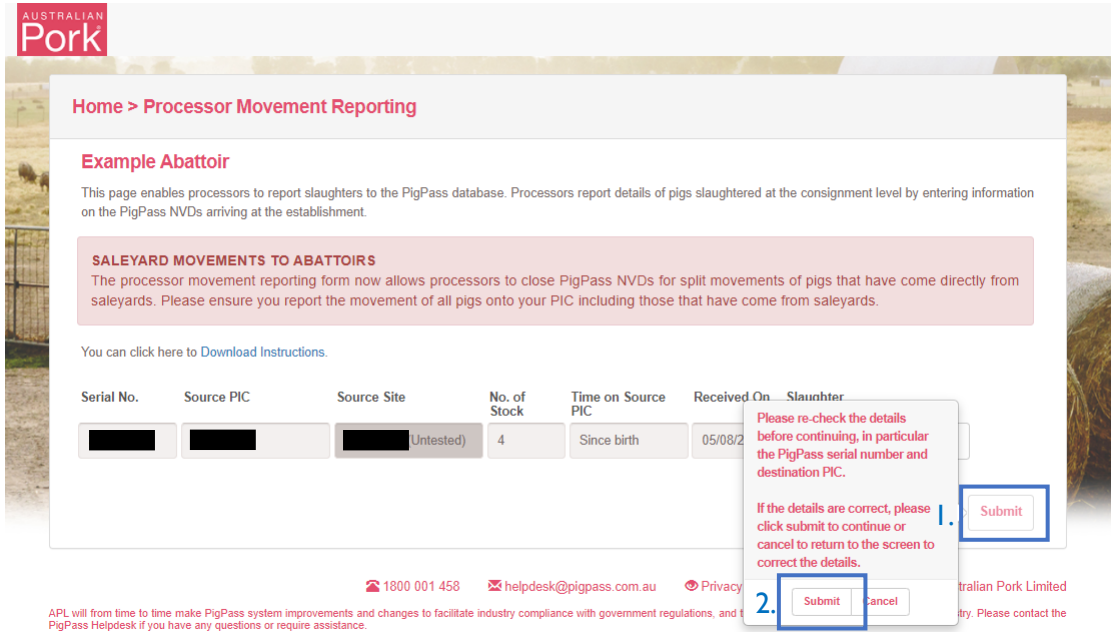

Step 8: If you would like delete any row then click on Bin icon as shown in the screen shot below.

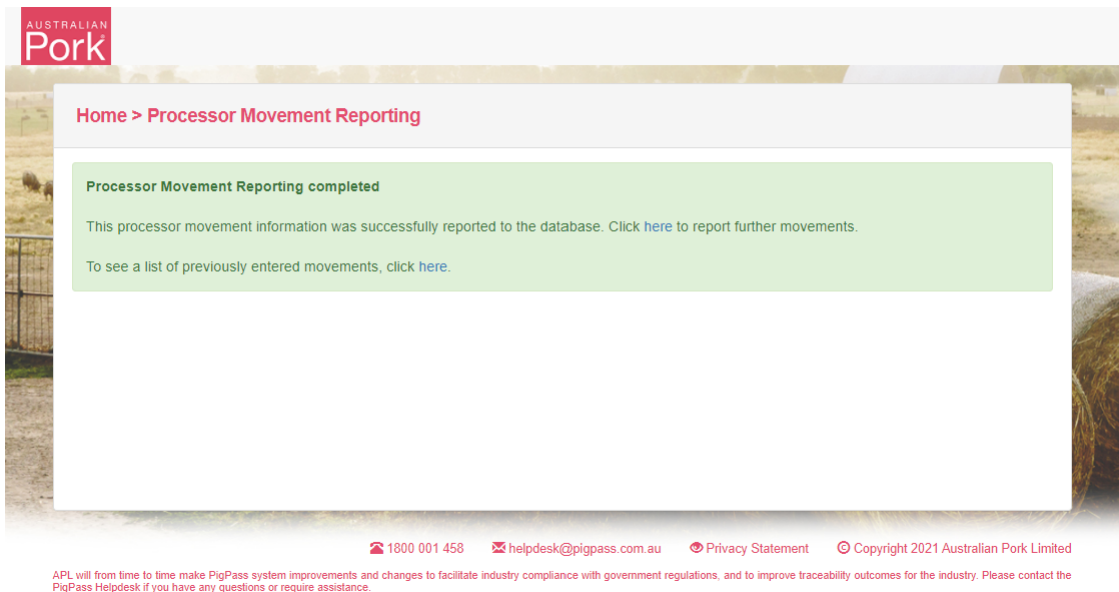
