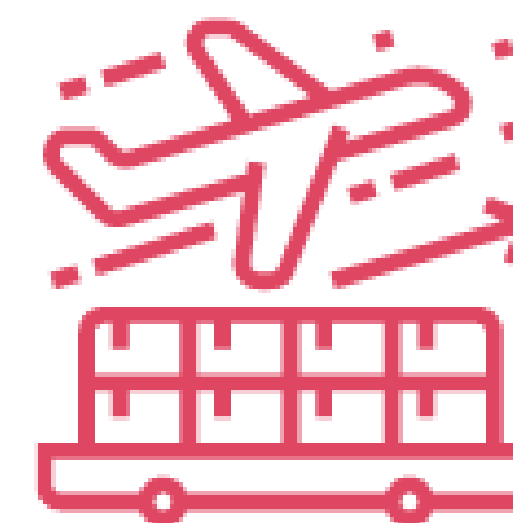

Graph 3.2: Value of Australian Farmed Pigmeat Exports Monthly and MAT

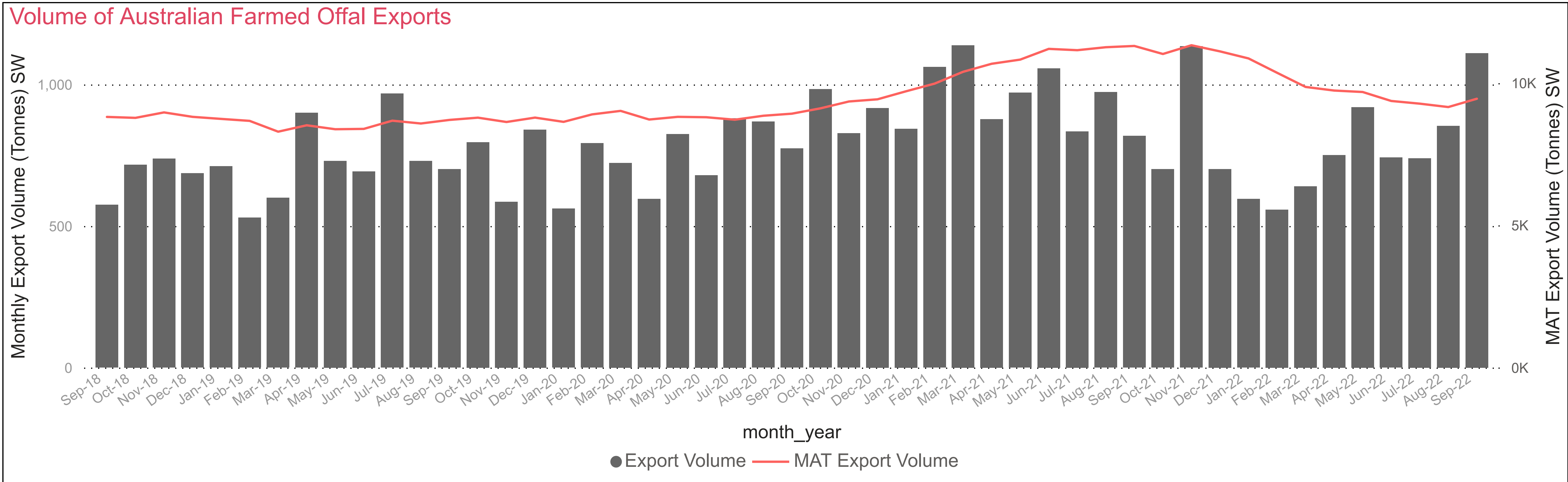

Graph 3.2a: Value of Australian Farmed Offal Exports Monthly and MAT



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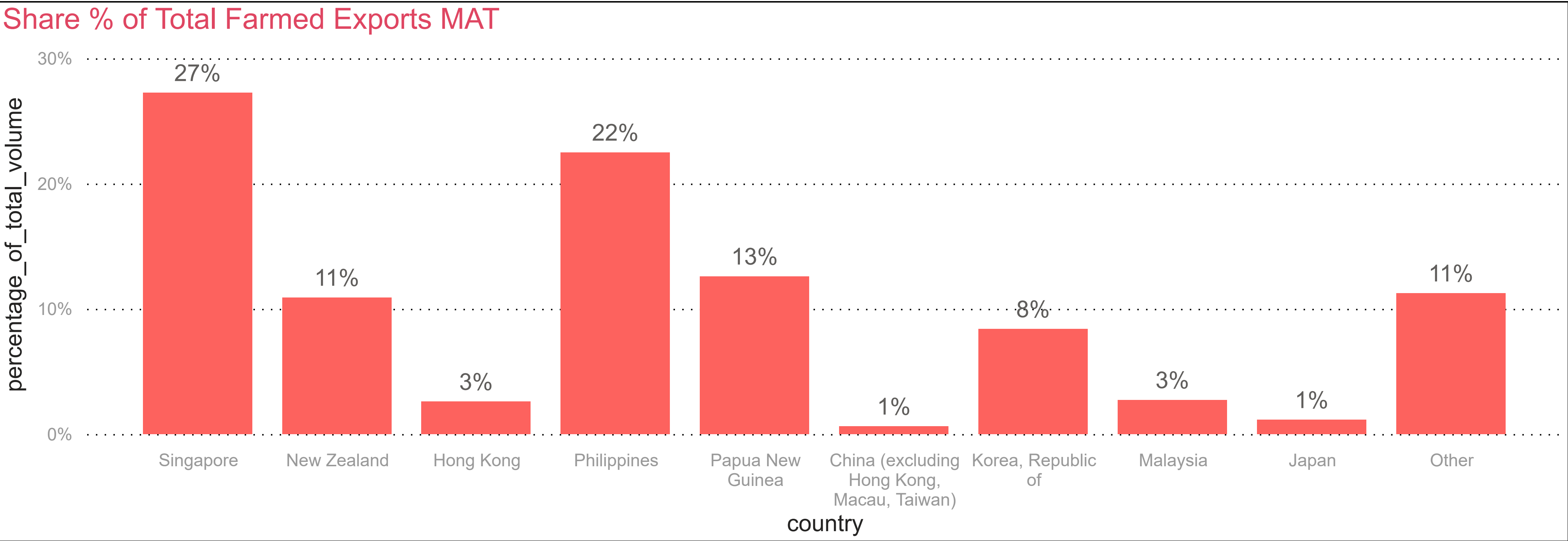

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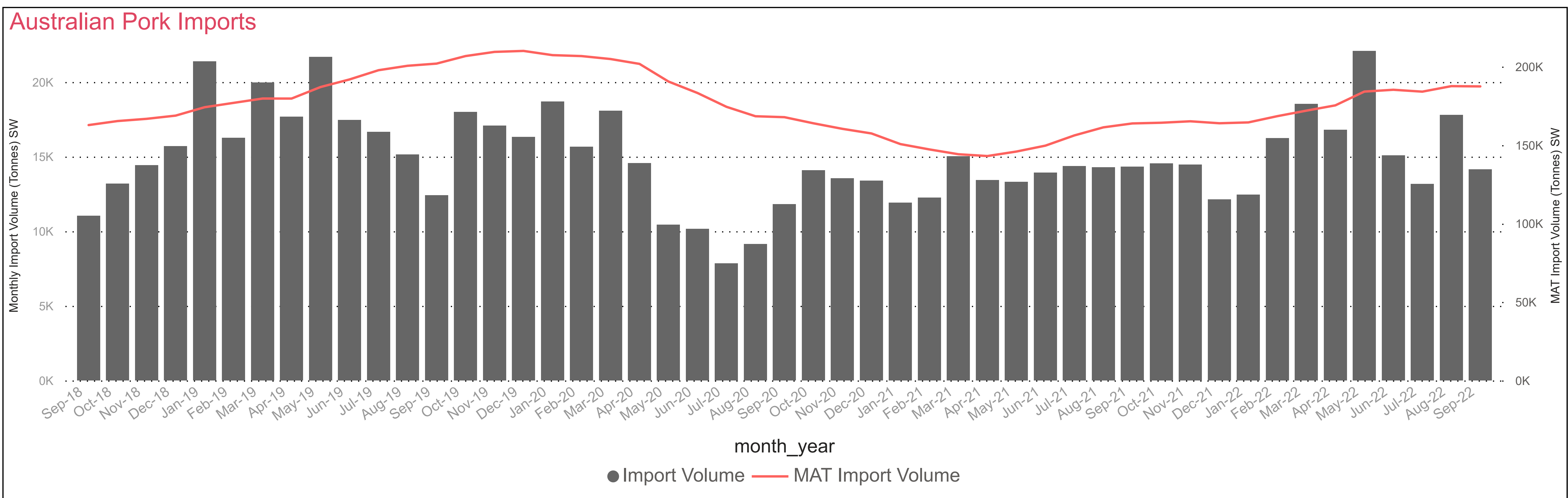

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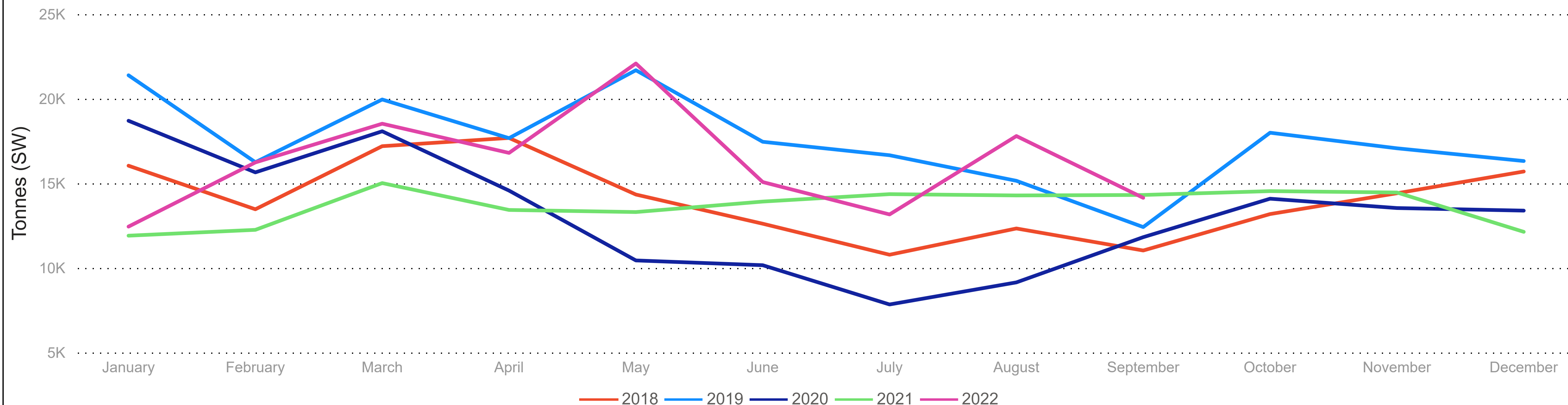

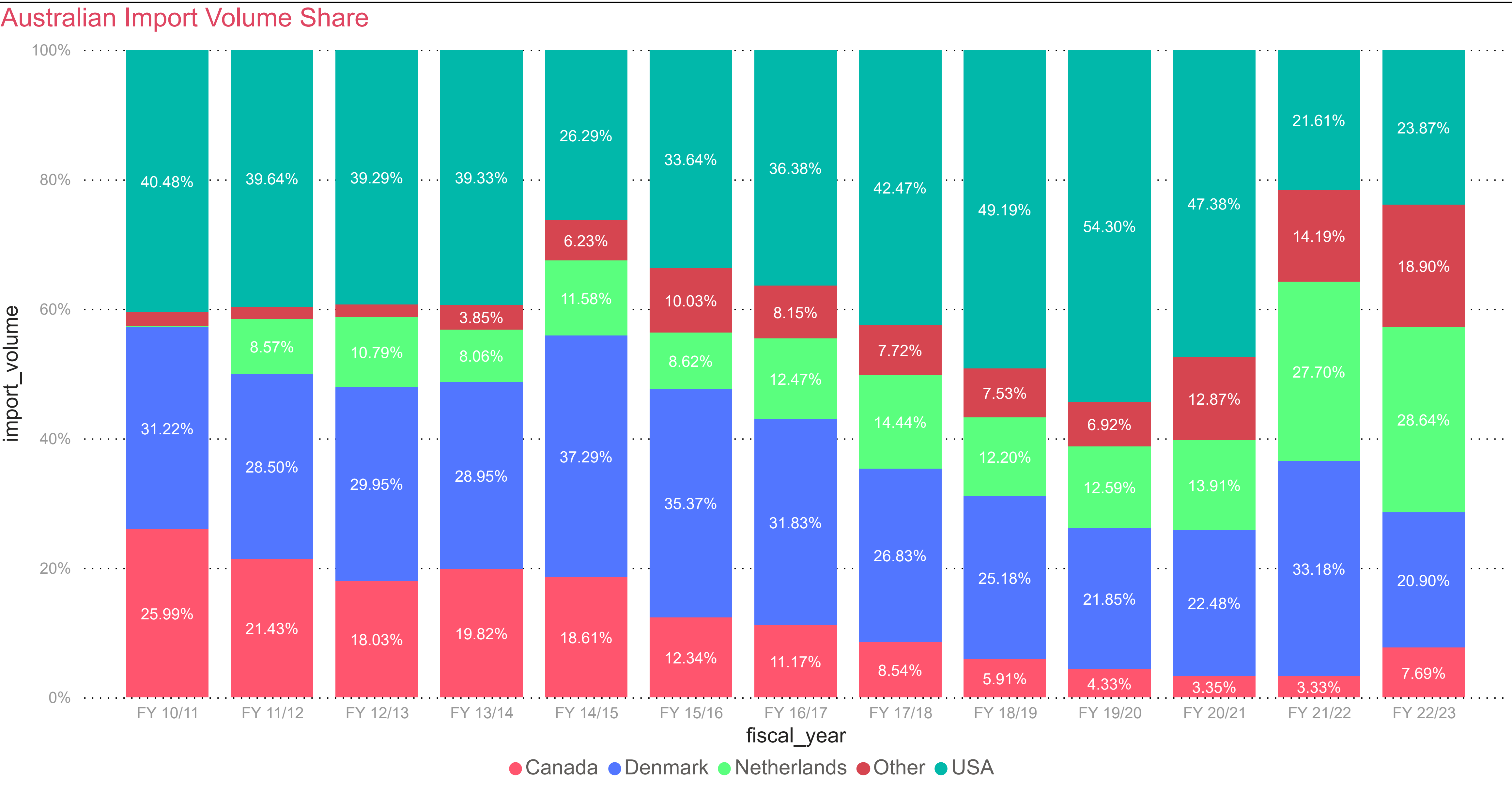
