To the point:

International and National

On the back of the continued war between Ukraine and Russia, Ukraine's harvest progress is now at the slowest since the nation gained its independence over 30 years ago, with corn and wheat in particular struggling.

Despite an ongoing conflict for Russia with Ukraine, the Russian agriculture minister stated that this week that labour shortages are not forecast for next season, however other reports have indicated that the country's rail logistics are under pressure from the war, which could cause issues.

Locally, Western Australian company CBH has seen over 2.18 million tonnes shipped throughout the last month, which is significantly higher than their previous record of 1.9 million tonnes in January of 2017.

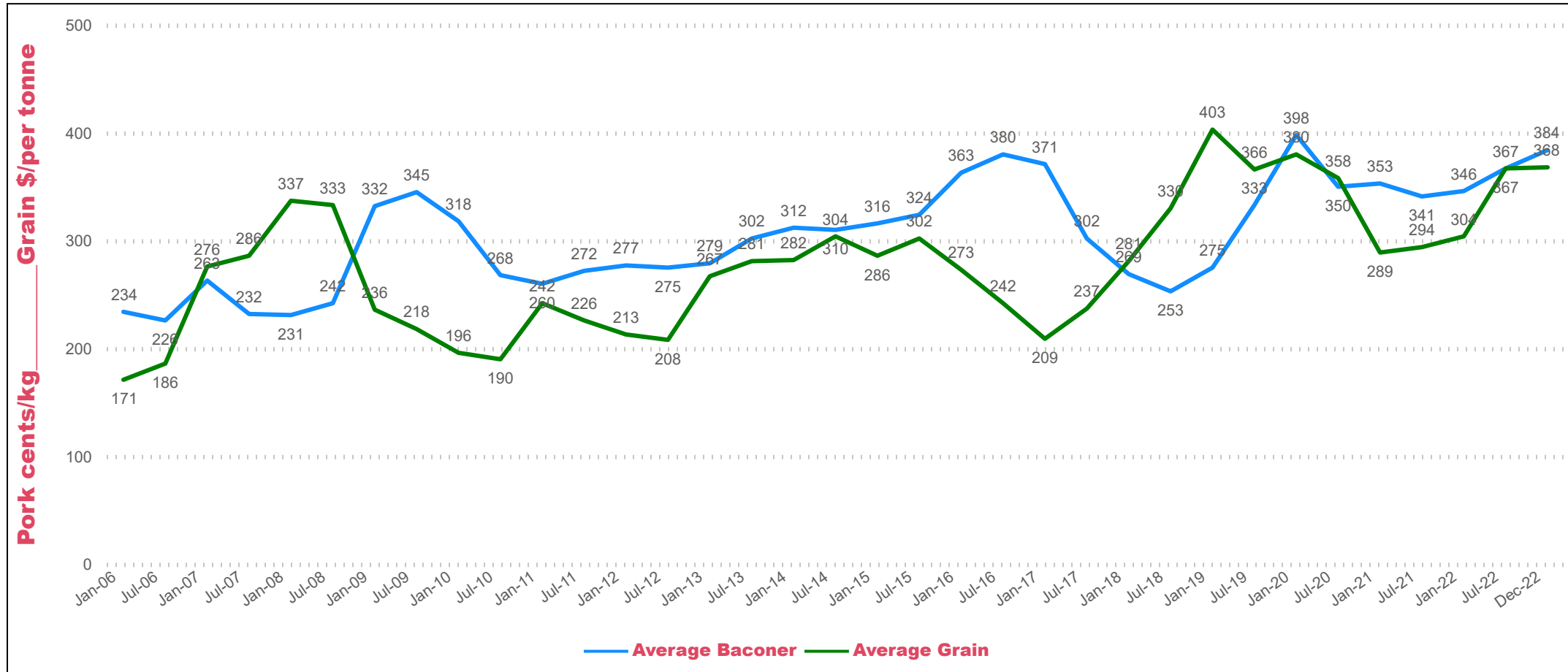
Viterra's networks in South Australia and Victoria have experienced another record month, with a total of 6.93 million tonnes total received up until New Year's Day, however, December 19th holds the record for an individual day with over 260,000 tonnes acquired for this season.

With drier and warmer conditions providing less logistical issues, GrainCorp deliveries have also significantly risen throughout New South Wales and Victoria over the holiday break, with over 2 million tonnes of grain acquired since December 19th, taking the total for this season to be just under 10 million tonnes.

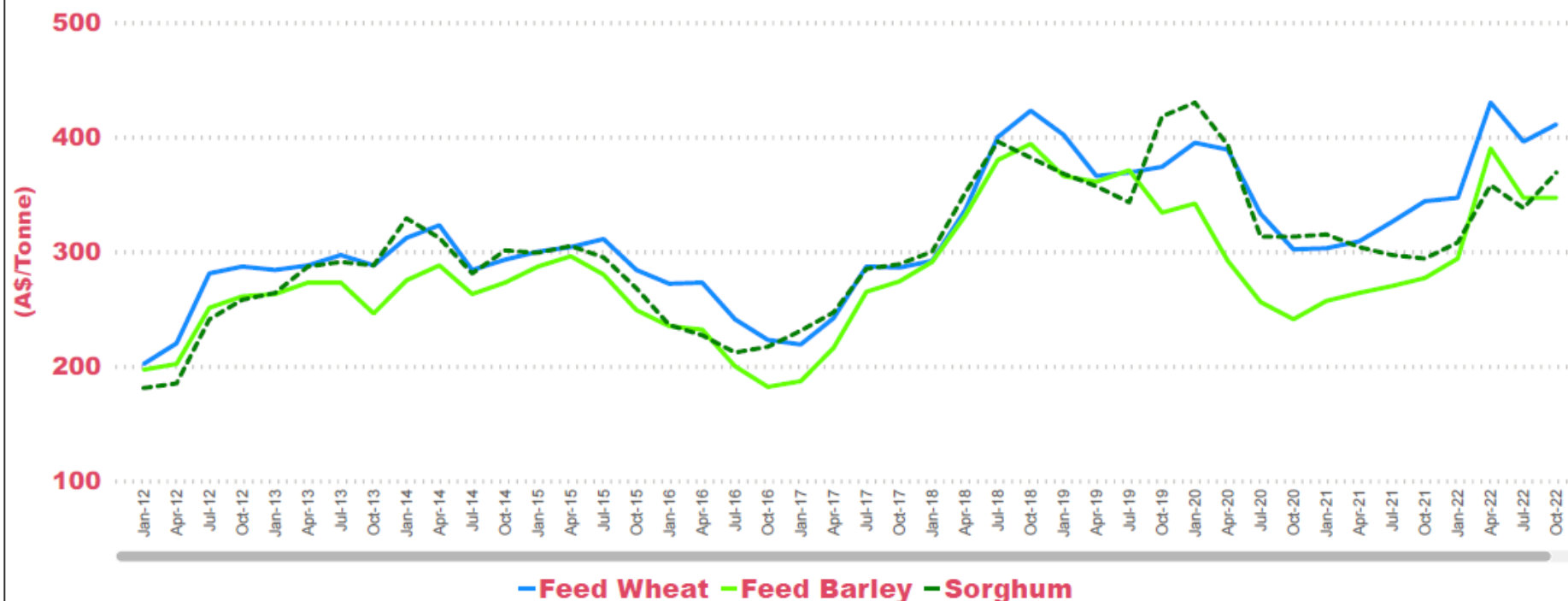
