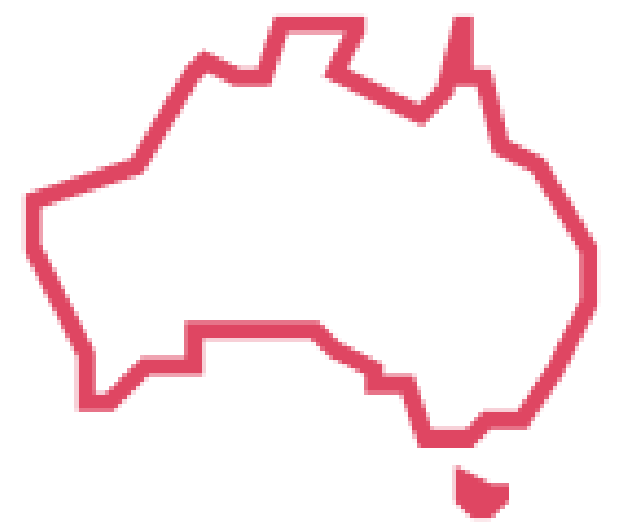

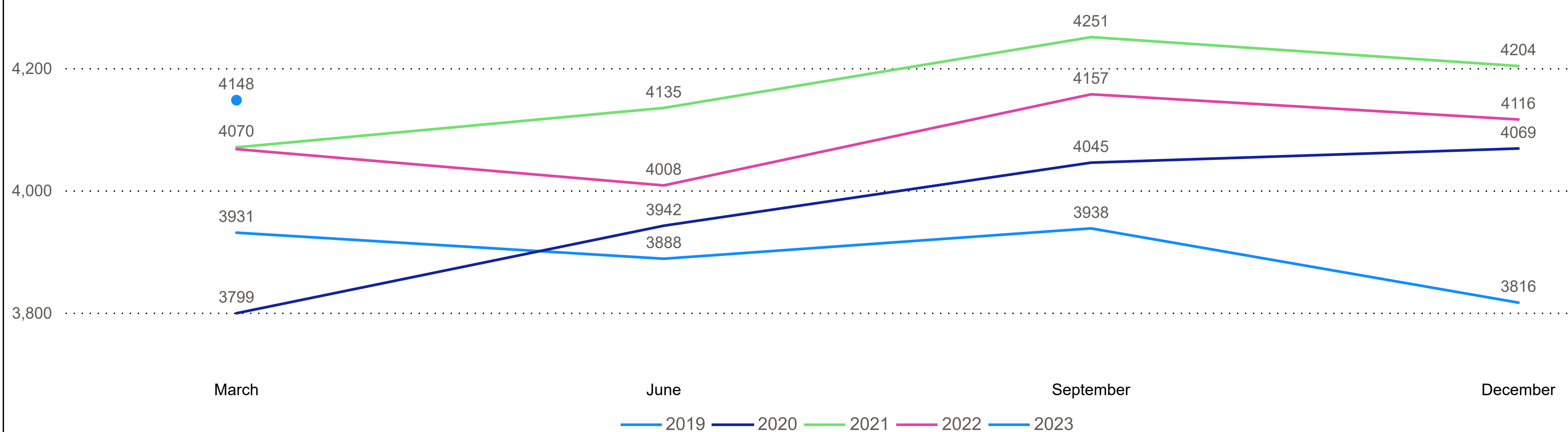

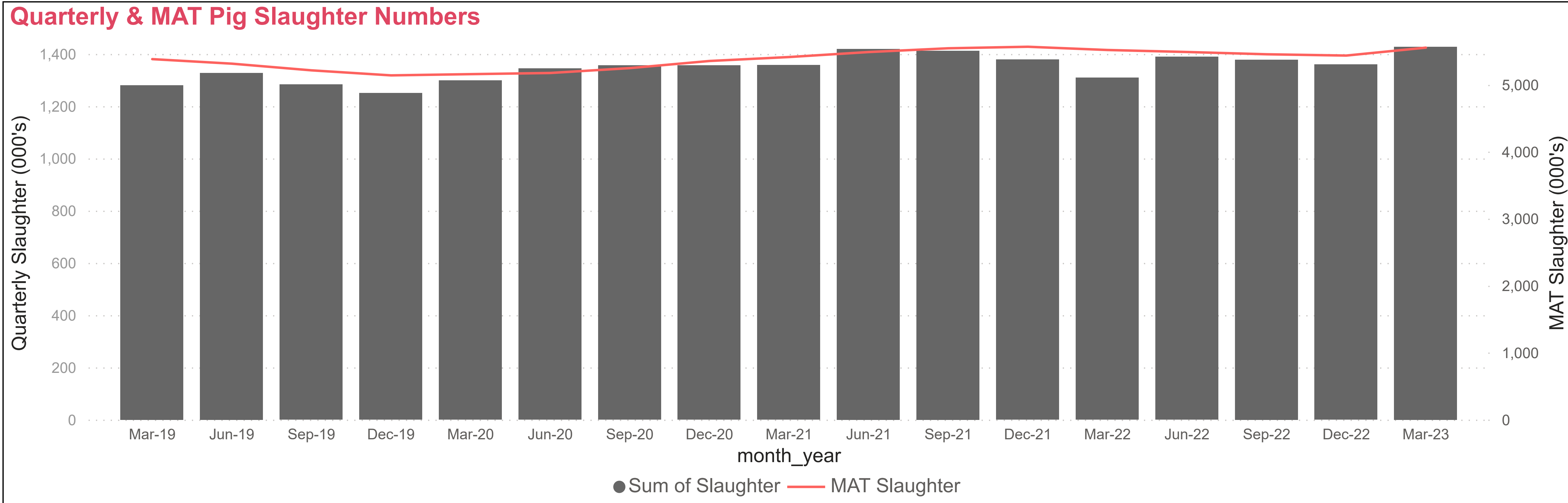

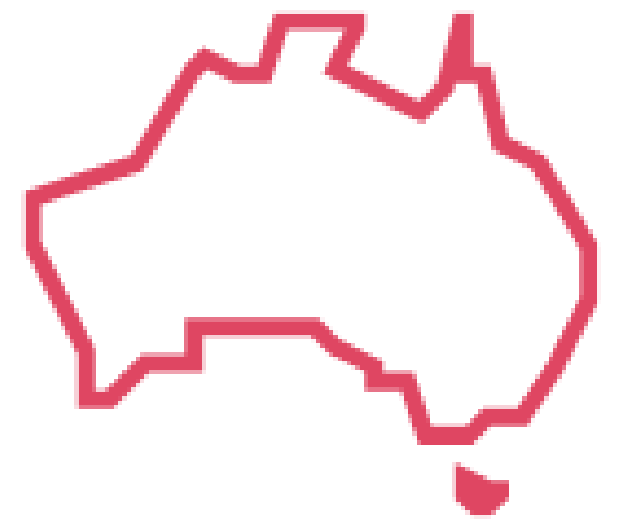
**Graph 2.1: Quarterly and MAT Pig Slaughter Numbers**

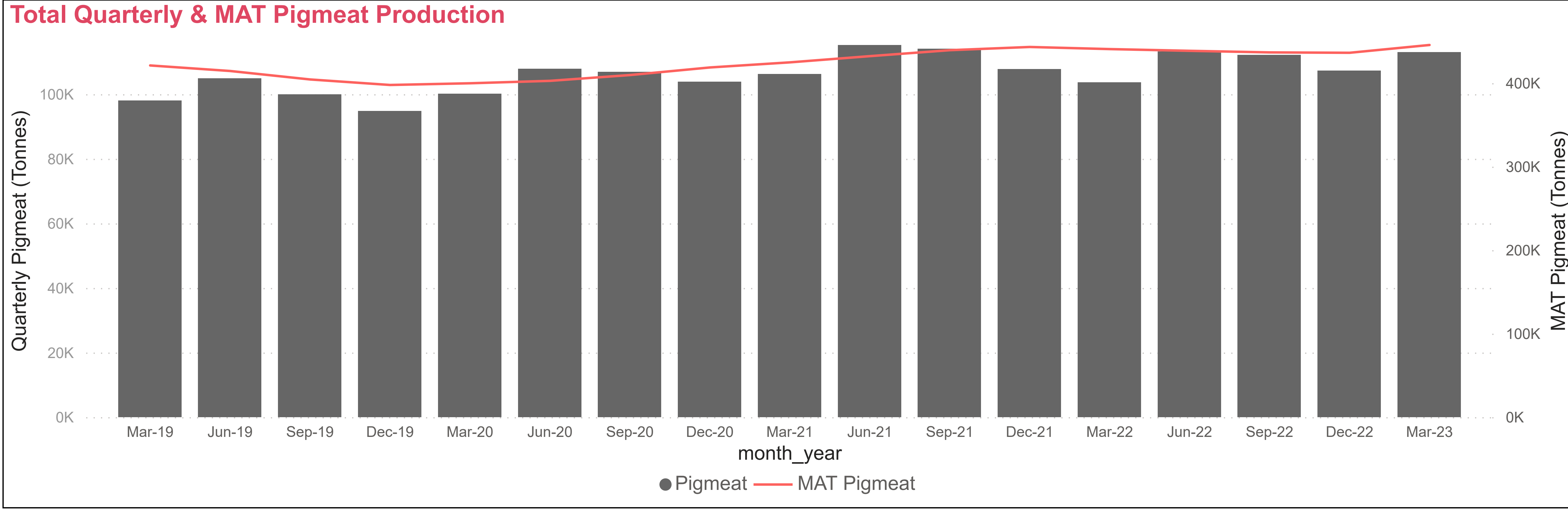

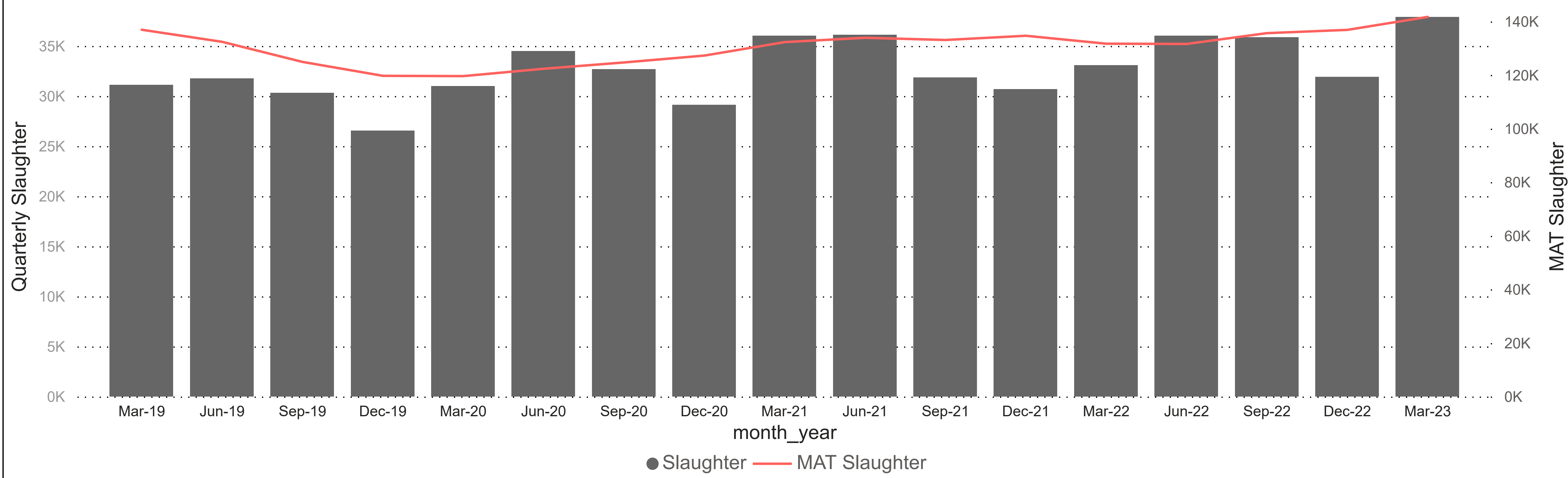

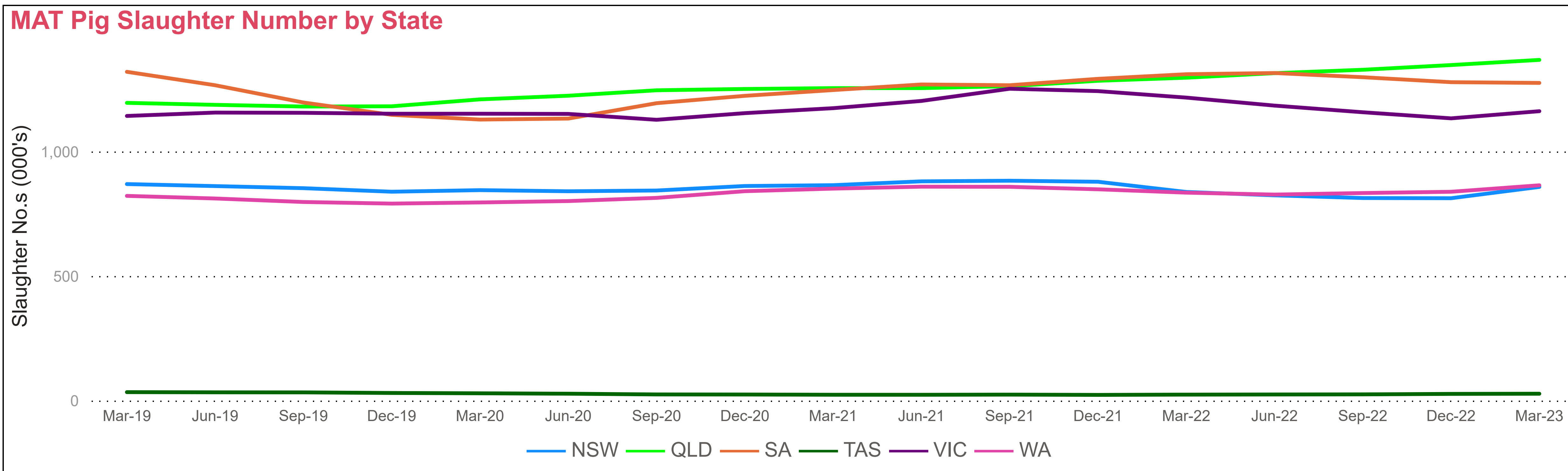
