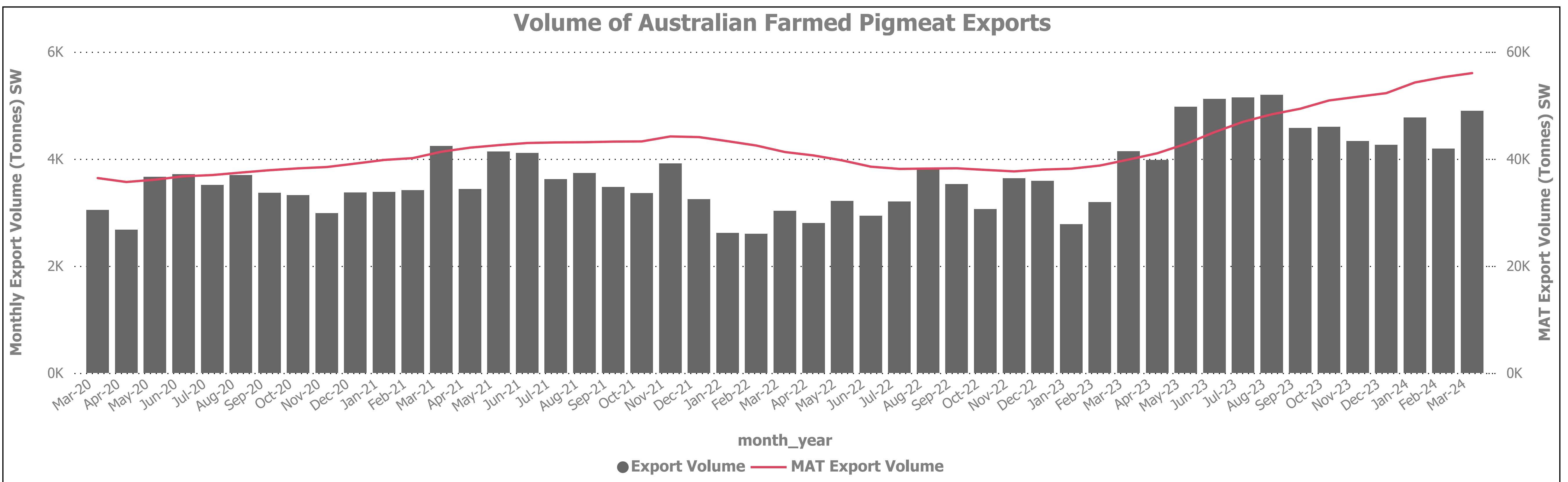

Graph 3.1: Volume of Australian Farmed Pigmeat Exports Monthly and MAT



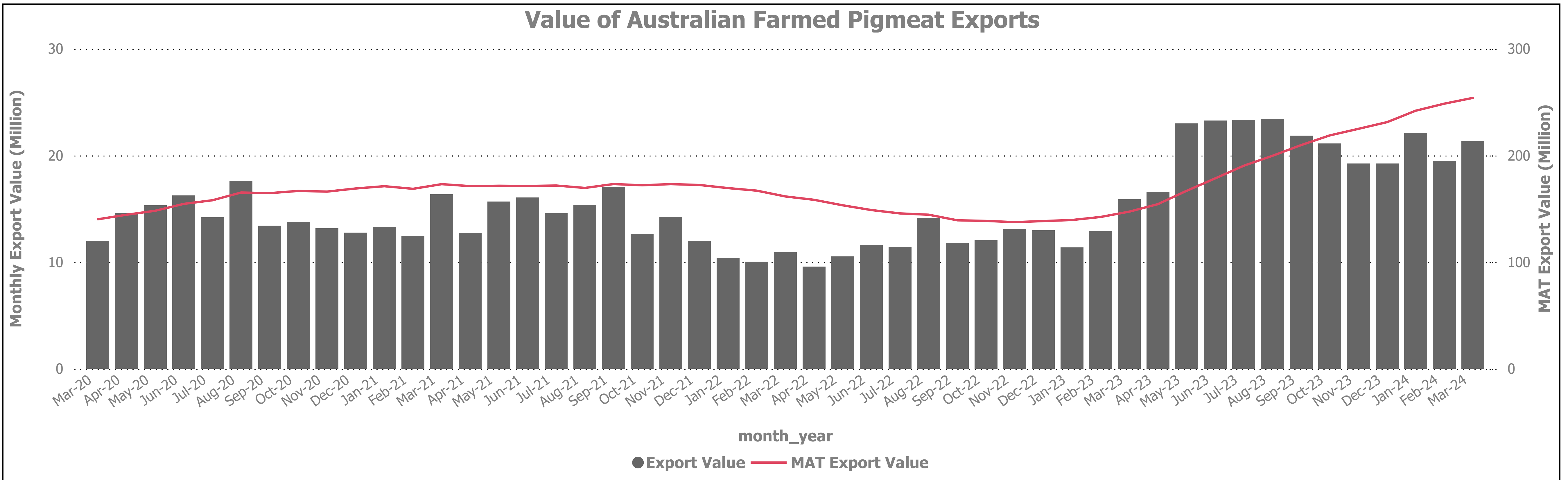

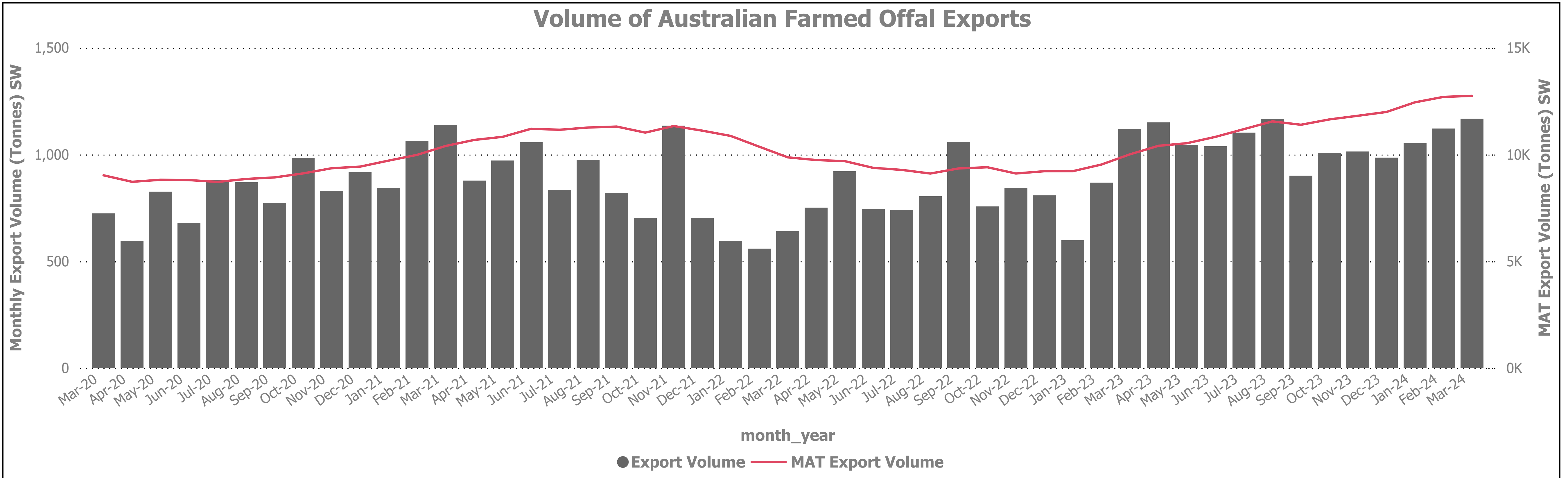

Graph 3.1a: Volume of Australian Farmed Offal Exports Monthly and MAT



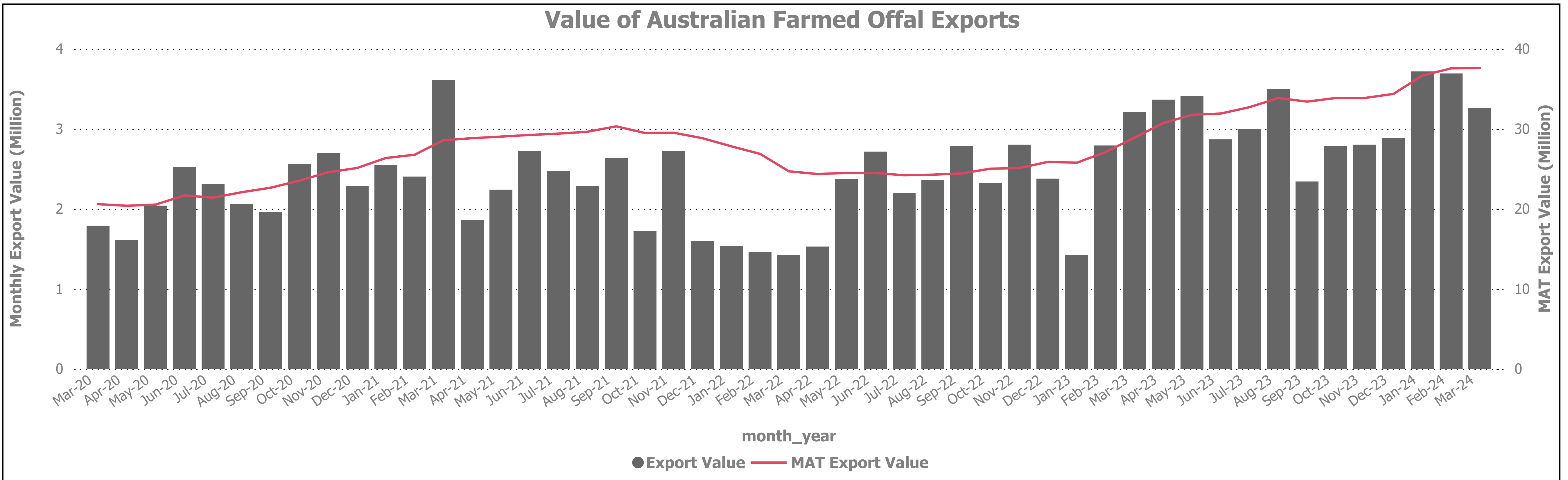

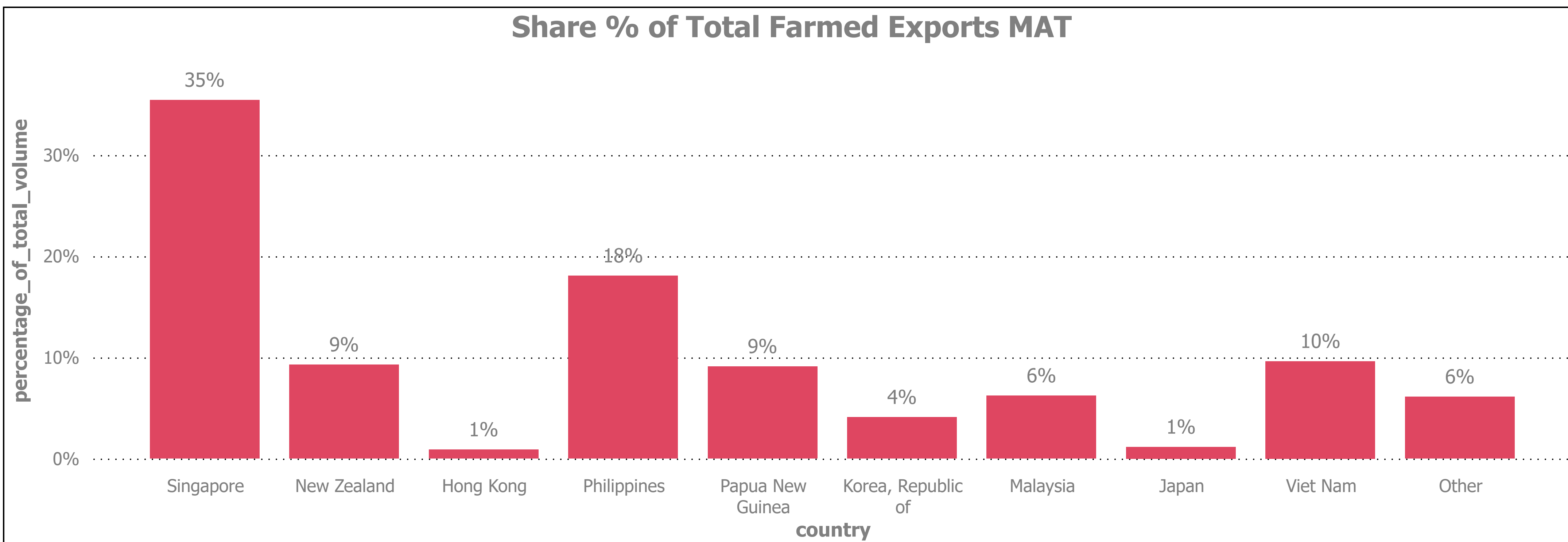

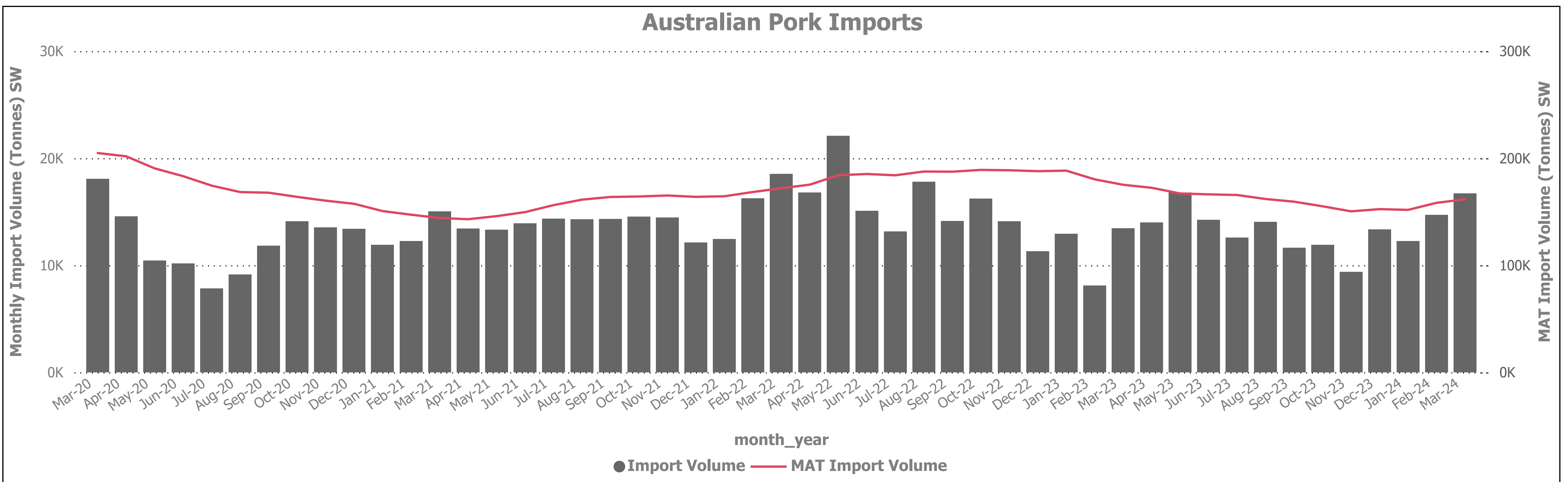

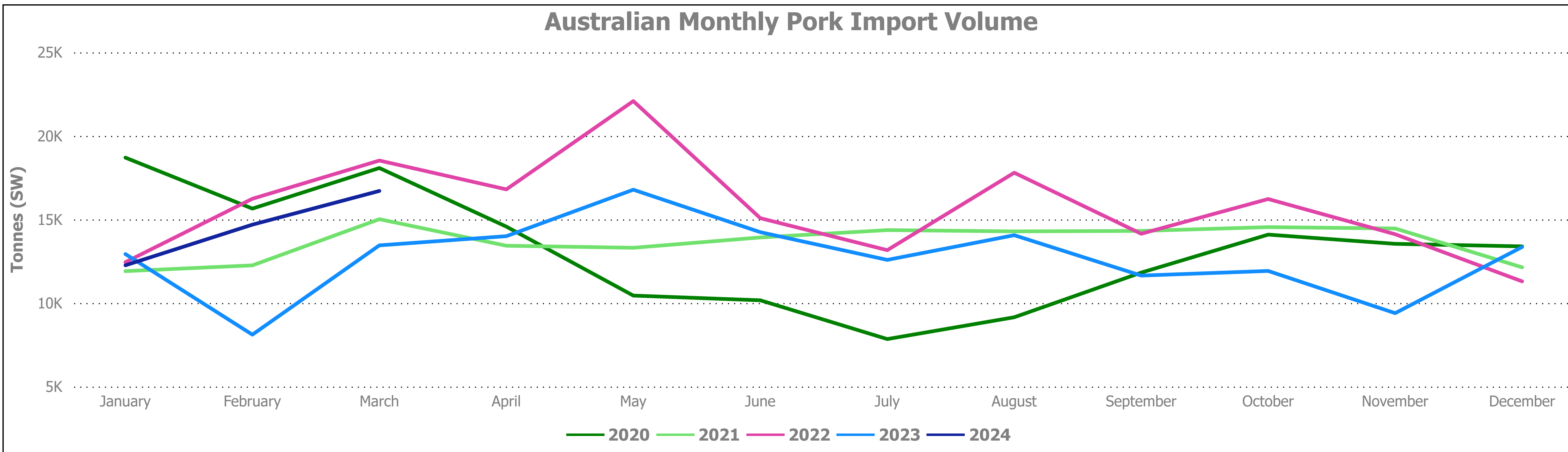

Graph 4.2: Australian Monthly Pork Import Volume Trends



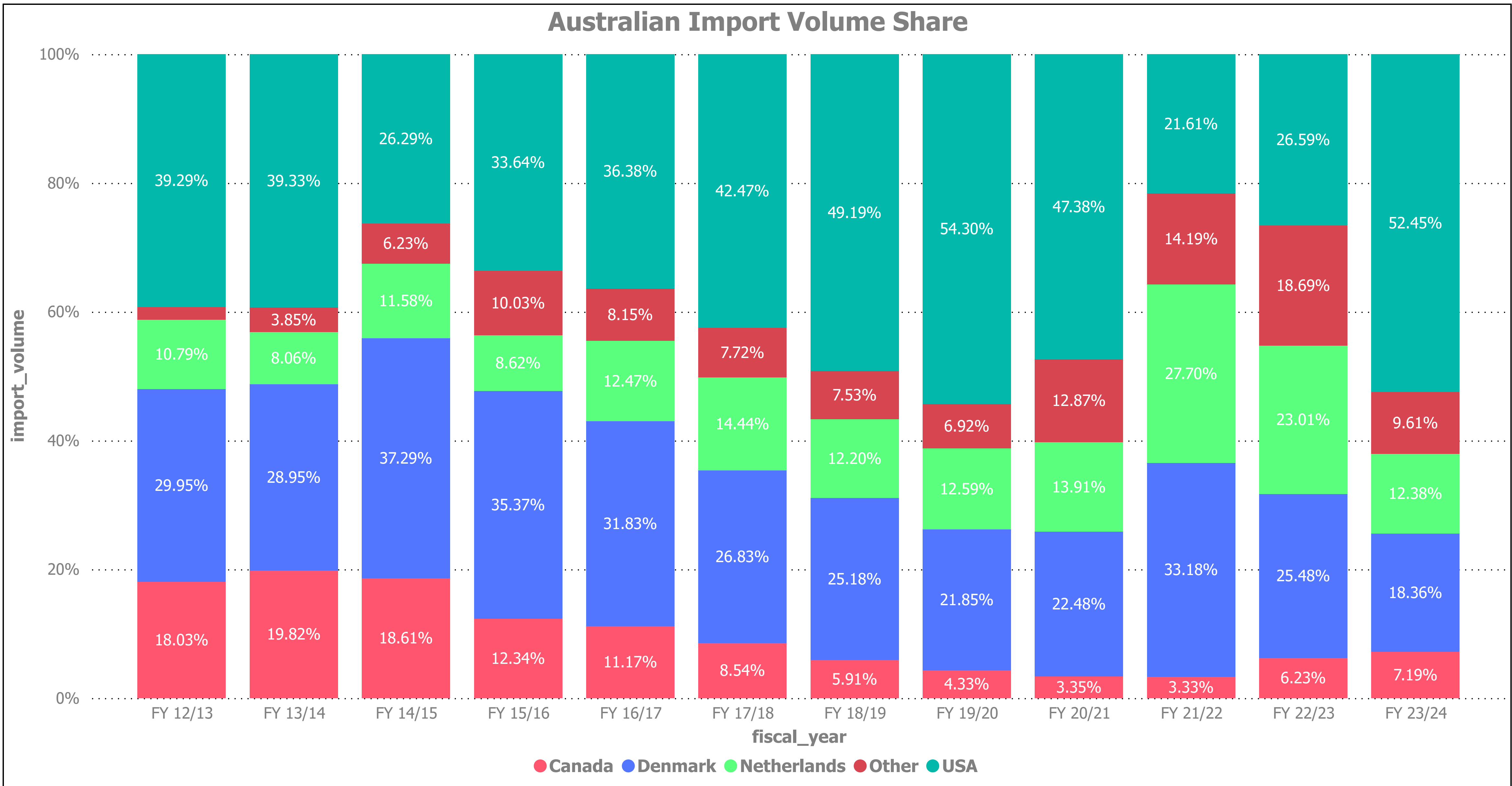
