Results: Week 49, 2025

APL continues to monitor national surveillance activities for Japanese encephalitis virus (JEV).

Latest Results:

- No confirmed clinical cases of JEV reported nationally in humans or animals.
- Queensland: Detection in piggery effluent samples.

We encourage producers to put mosquito control measures in place now. Guidance is available in the [Integrated Mosquito Management Principles for Piggeries](#).

Vaccination against JEV is also recommended for all people working at, residing at or providing services to pig farm and abattoir enterprises.
