Latest Results:

No confirmed clinical cases of JEV reported nationally in humans or animals.

Queensland: <u>Detection</u> in piggery effluent samples.

We encourage producers to put mosquito control measures in place now. Guidance is

available in the Integrated Mosquito Management Principles for Piggeries.

Vaccination against JEV is also recommended for all people working at, residing at or

providing services to pig farm and abattoir enterprises.
