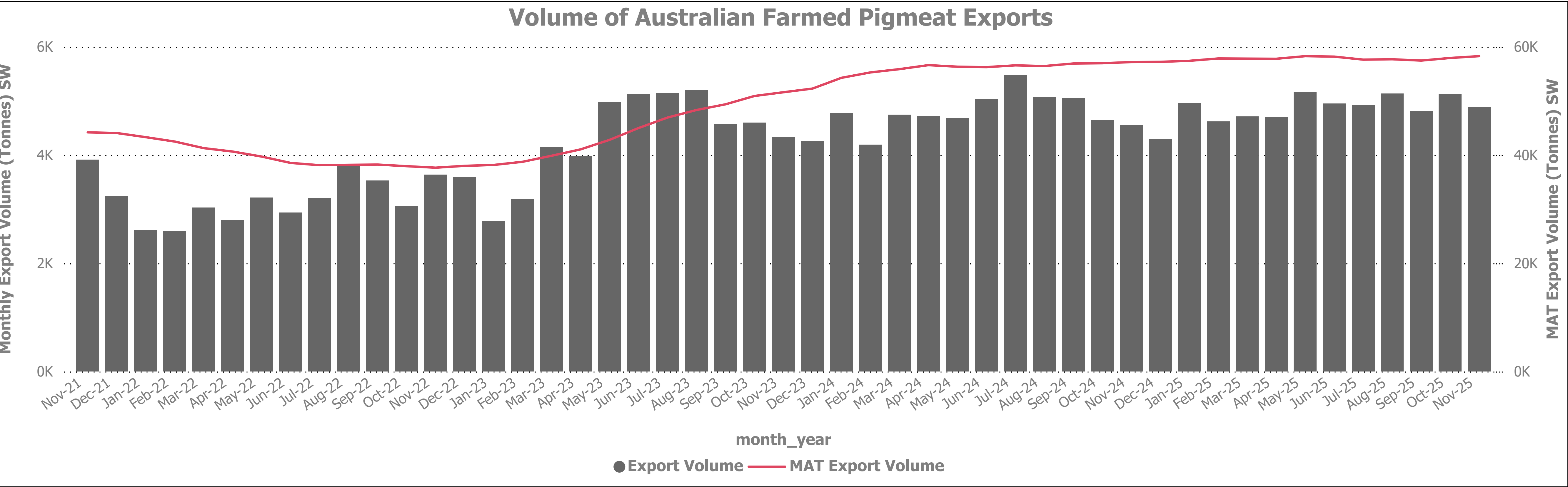

Volume of Australian Farmed Pigmeat Exports



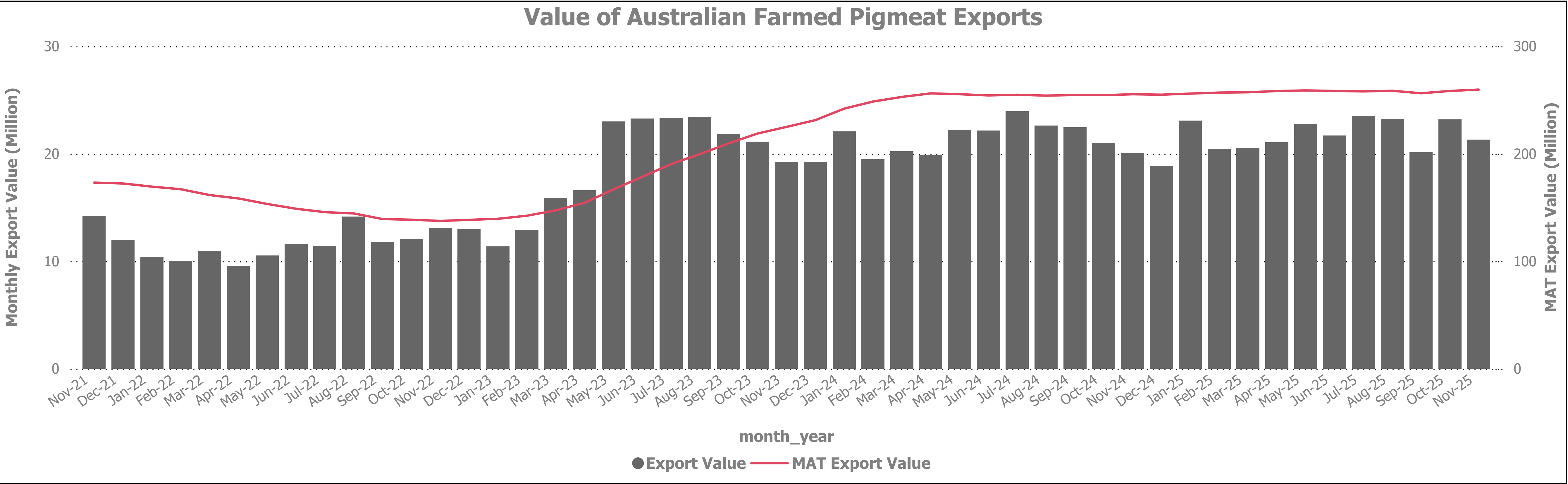

Graph 3.2: Value of Australian Farmed Pigmeat Exports Monthly and MAT





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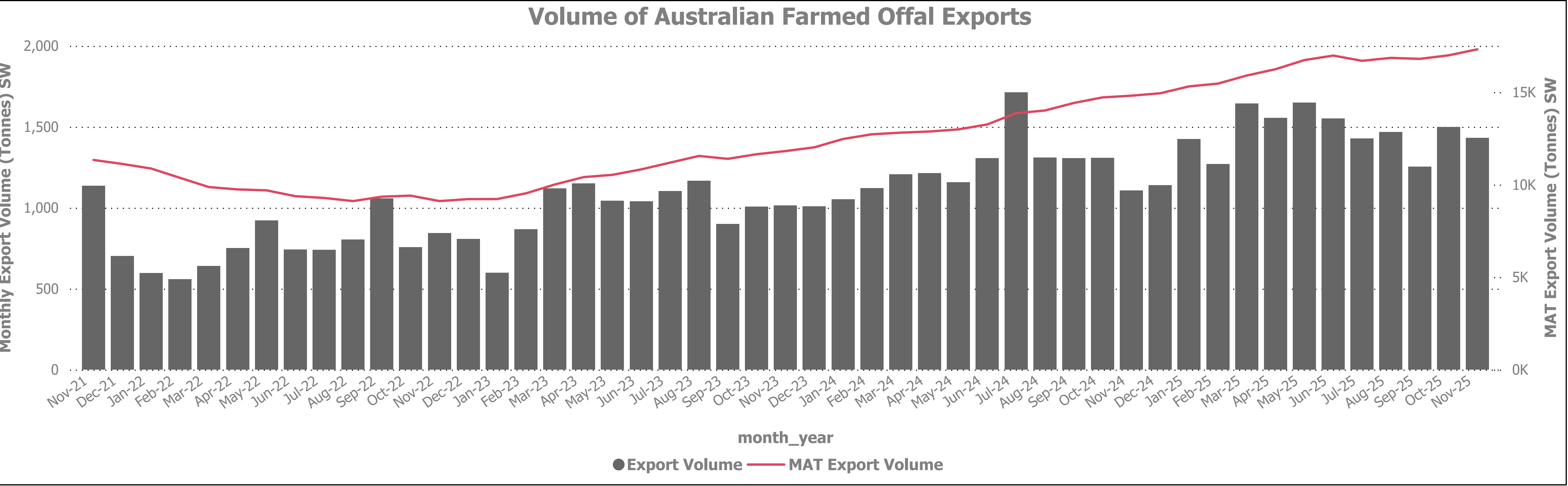

Graph 3.1a: Volume of Australian Farmed Offal Exports Monthly and MAT



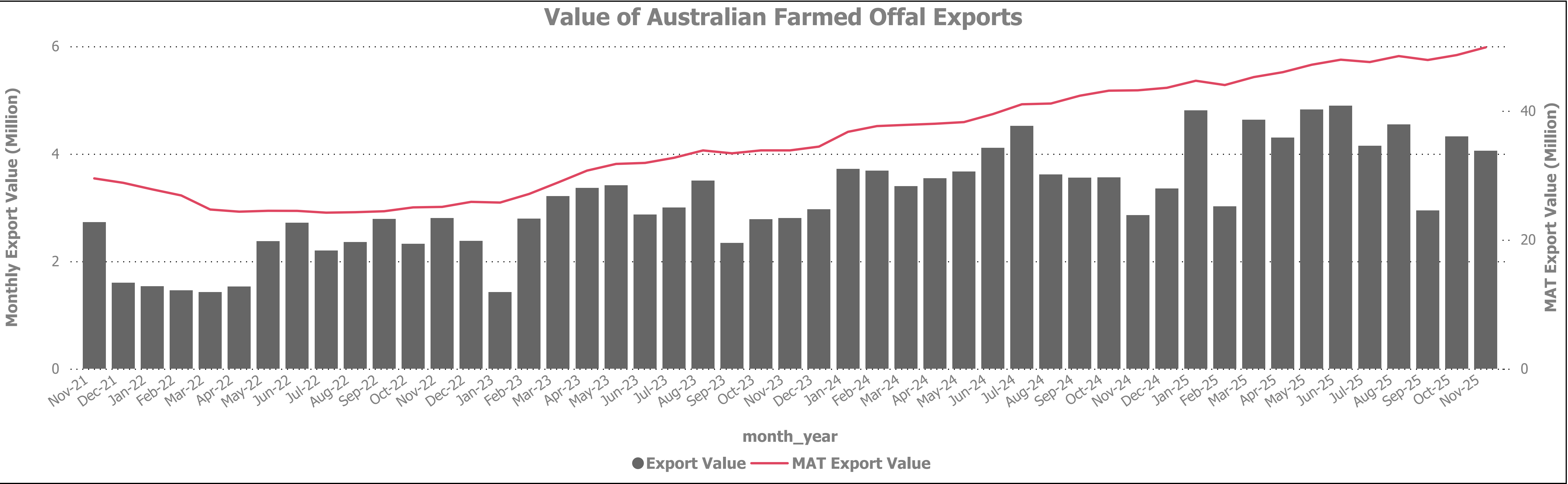

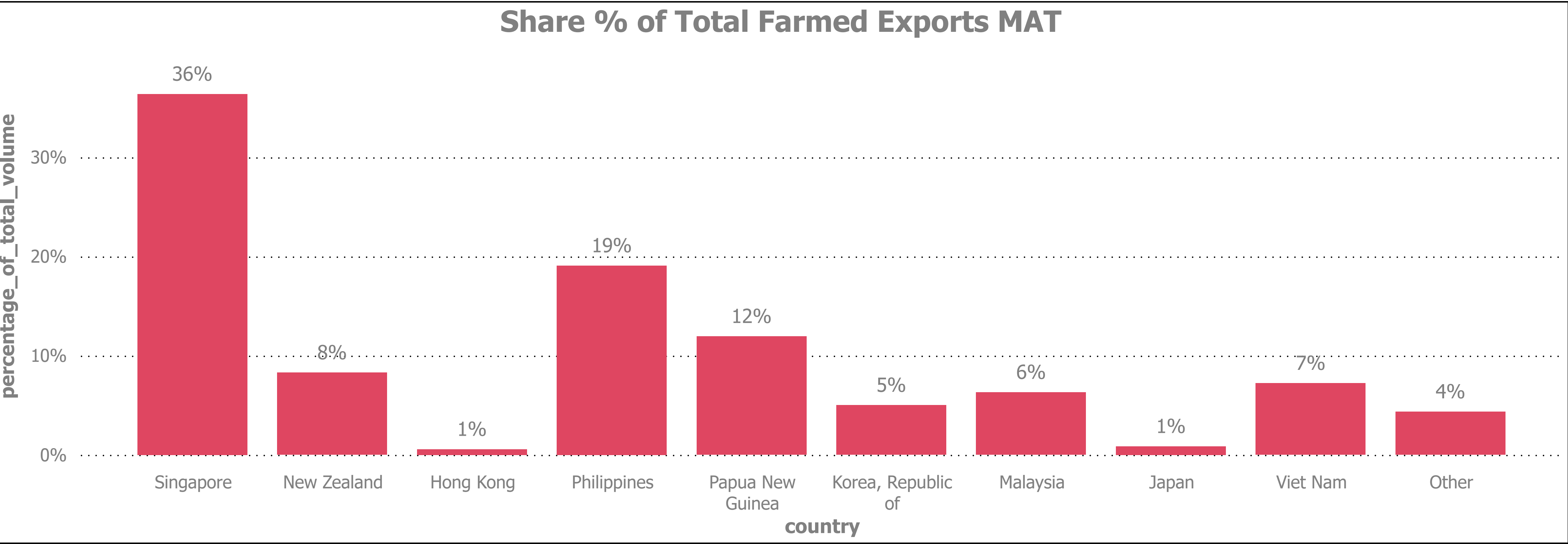

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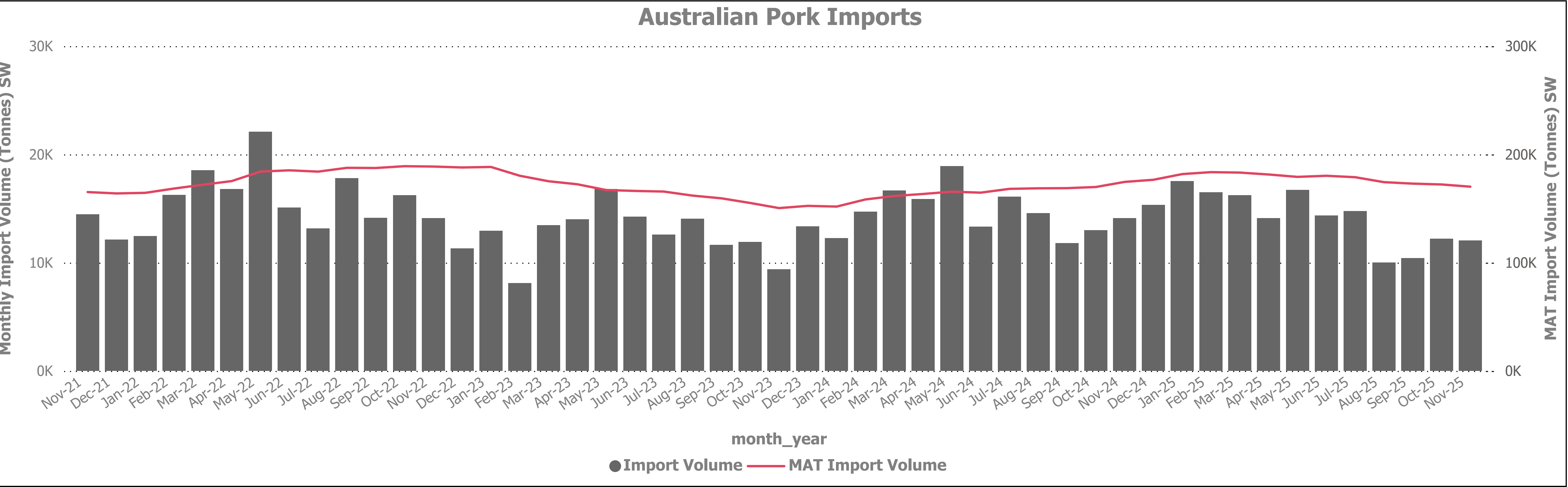

Graph 4.1: Volume of Australian Pork Imports Monthly and MAT





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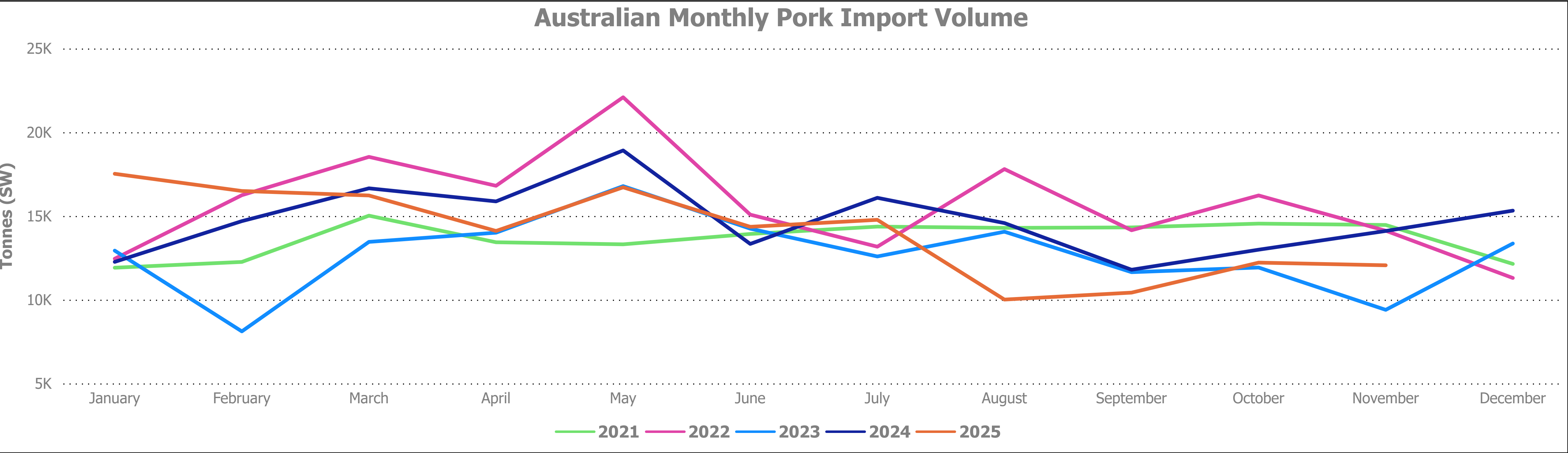
